# Hunt on but no trace yet of AN-32

**New Delhi:** It will now take a miracle to find alive any of the 29 people on board the ill-fated AN-32, which went missing on way to Port Blair from Chennai on Friday morning, with the massive search operation mounted by warships and aircraft as well as satellites not yielding any concrete result till now.



"It is like searching for needle in the haystack," an officer said of the search for the missing AN-32 aircraft

"It's very unfortunate that we have not been able to trace the missing aircraft and the personnel on board. It's a very difficult moment for all of us and we share the concerns of the distraught family mem-

bers," said IAF chief Air Chief Marshal Arup Raha on Monday.

The IAF Navy and Coast Guard are carrying on the search operation, with 17 war-

hips, 23 aircraft and helicopters, and a submarine continuing the hunt in the "extended probable crash zone" spanning around 3.7 lakh square km in the Bay of Bengal. "It's like searching for a needle in a haystack. The leads given by satellite imaging are being investigated...but till now they have led us to wooden logs, cylinders and parts of fishing boats, and not any debris of the AN-32," said a senior officer.

The last radar contact with the AN-32, which underwent a life-extension upgrade in September 2015, but had suffered three technical snags earlier this month, indicates it went

into a steep downward spiral from a 23,000-foot altitude about 151 nautical miles east of Chennai at 9.12 am on Friday, as was reported by TOI earlier.

Arup Raha said capabilities of AN-32s have been exploited as the "workhorse of the IAF" over the last three decades of its operations. "Because of their excellent operational performance, we have been landing the AN-32s at Daulat Beg Oldie (near the Line of Actual Control with China in eastern Ladakh), which is the highest landing ground in the world. Needless to say that capable aircraft are chosen to fly these aircraft," he said.

# Locator may no longer be of help

**New Delhi:** Time is fast running out to locate the missing AN-32 through its emergency locator transmitter (ELT) signals or beacon fixed on the medium-lift transport aircraft's tail fin. While the signals are strong for the first 48 hours or so after activation of ELT during a crash, they generally become weaker and sporadic as time goes by.

The ill-fated AN-32, with the call sign AF-330, seems to have gone down on Friday

morning in a region in the Bay of Bengal where the average sea depth is over 3,000-metre, which makes the search all the more difficult.

An ELT gets automatically activated by an impact with a certain amount of G-force roughly equivalent to a crash, while the aircrew's personal locator beacons (PLBs) are geared for activation on coming in touch with seawater.

"But the general battery life of the beacons is 48 hours. After that, the signals gradu-

ally weaken before dying. Sometimes, the ELTs fail to get activated during a crash. In the present case, it will be extremely difficult to pick up ELT signals from the deep seabed in the possible crash region," he added.

## TIME RUNNING OUT

Coast Guard commander (East) inspector general Rajan Bargartha in Chennai on Monday said the ELTs on the last two Dornier crashes in

the sea had failed to get activated. "It is a matter of concern which has been taken up with the equipment manufacturer and they will be looking into it," he said.

Incidentally, the AN-32 that crashed was among the 50 such twin-turboprop aircraft upgraded till now with airframe strengthening to increase their operational life from the earlier 25 years to 40 as well as newer avionics under the \$398 million (Rs 1,965 crore) contract inked with Ukraine in June 2009.

# Unpaid Chhattisgarh teacher kills himself

**Raipur:** A contract schoolteacher in Chhattisgarh hanged himself to death after being unable to meet daily expenses as he was not paid his salary in the last four months, police said on Monday.

More than 40% of contract teachers in Chhattisgarh have not been paid regularly, the sta-

te association of Shiksha Karmis alleged.

Forty-year-old Nankeshwar Ram's body was found hanging in his house at Jhagribahar village in Jashpur district. The state school education employees' association president said that 60% of teachers were paid only after protests, adding that teachers were unable to meet even medical expenses.

# 2 arrested for rape of Israeli tourist

**Manali:** Police on Monday arrested two men from Himachal Pradesh's Kullu for the gangrape of a 25-year-old Israeli woman on Sunday.

The woman alleged that she was gang raped by six men who offered her a lift in a car near Manali. The other four accused are still at large. The vehicle allegedly used in the crime has also been impounded. **TNN**

# Court gives nod to Jindal for UAE business trip

**New Delhi:** A special court on Monday allowed Congress leader and industrialist Naveen Jindal, accused in the Amarkonda Murgandanga coal scam, to travel abroad from July 26 to 30 for business purposes.

Special CBI Judge Bharat Parashar allowed the plea filed by Jindal, who is on bail, seeking the court's permission to go to UAE, but imposed some conditions. While granting bail to Jindal, the court had made it clear that he will not leave the country without the court's nod.

CBI had also charge-sheeted ex-Minister of State for Coal Dasari Narayan Rao, ex-Jharkhand chief minister Madhu Koda, former Coal Secretary HC Gupta and 11 others in the case of alleged irregularities in allocation of Amarkonda Murgandanga coal block in Jharkhand to Jindal Steel and Power Ltd (JSPL) and Gagan Sponge Iron Private Ltd (GSIPL). **TNN**

# JD(U) MLA booked for mill landgrab

**Patna:** A lawmaker of Bihar's ruling JD(U) was on Sunday booked for allegedly trying to grab a sugar mill and its land in the state's Siwan district. According to an FIR lodged by a doctor, Vikram Singh, MLA Shyam Bahadur Singh (49), his son, son-in-law and other associates were trying to usurp his sugar mill and its land worth Rs 20 lakh.

However, senior police officer Alok Raj said it was not a case of extortion, and one case each had been lodged by both sides. The MLA from Siwan's Barharia has also accused the doctor of illegally grabbing the mill. Another senior police officer said the cases would be investigated and supervised by a senior officer, and action taken accordingly. No arrests have been made.

JD (U) had early this month sought an explanation from Singh after a video showing him dancing with two "nautch" girls at a village function in Bihar went viral. Four similar videos have gone viral in the last four years, sources said.

# Simultaneous LS, assembly polls idea faces legal hurdles

**New Delhi:** It was an idea that found place in the BJP manifesto and got a keen Prime Minister's Office to raise it with the Election Commission, but over two years into the government's tenure, a realization of the practical and legal challenges in operationalising it has begun to set in.

The two key Constitutional provisions that make it virtually impossible to maintain the synchronised cycle of parliamentary and assembly elections are Article 356 and right of government and elected representatives to move confidence and no-confidence motions respectively. Not to mention the voting on key bills in Parliament, with defeat of a money bill signifying loss of majority for the government.

An EC functionary pointed out that unlike a presidential system that provides for a fixed term, the parliamentary system followed here allows for early dissolution of Lok Sabha and state

assemblies through valid instruments like Article 356 and trust/no-trust votes.

"Even if we were to somehow align terms of Lok Sabha and various state assemblies over the next few years, there is no way we can ensure their fixed terms until Article 356 remains in the statute," conceded an expert.

This is something an internal committee of the law ministry is deliberating upon after having received

comments of the election watchdog. The law ministry was asked to prepare a comprehensive report studying various options and the feasibility of holding simultaneous polls before the government decides on initiating an all-party discussion on the issue. The law ministry panel has been asked to submit its report by this month end.

Even the EC, in its comments to the law ministry, had suggested national deba-

te, consensus-building, consultations with states and political parties and constitutional amendments as steps towards its operationalisation.

Of course, EC maintains that it can synchronize Lok Sabha and state polls if the government amends the Constitution to curtail or extend terms of the state assemblies. Alternatively, polls to the state assemblies may be held in two phases over the Lok Sabha's five-year term. This means that polls due in first half of the Lok Sabha's term would be clubbed with the parliamentary poll, while those due in the second half may be held two-and-a-half years later. Another suggestion is to club all elections due in a given year in one round, possibly timed in the middle of that year.

"We can pull off simultaneous polls provided the logistics are arranged," a commission official said adding that this would require procuring EVMs at a cost of Rs 10,000 crore, with the economic life of each EVM being 15 years.
