Sacked Goa RSS leader floats parallel unit, blames Parrikar, Gadkari for acti

Panaji, Sept 1: Subhash Velingkar who was sacked as RSS Goa unit chief, on Thursday said he and his supporters would function independently of the parent body at least till the assembly polls as he blamed Union ministers Manohar Parrikar and Nitin Gadkari for his removal from the Sangh.

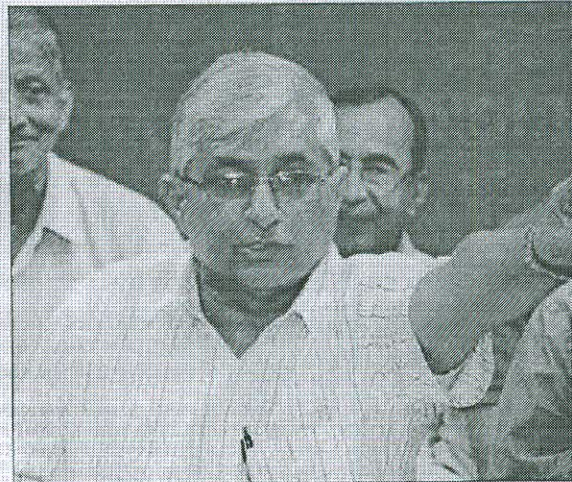
"Last night, several RSS workers have resigned from their posts. We have now split from Konkarn prant for forming a separate RSS Goa prant," Velingkar told reporters here.

He, however, hastened to add, "We will approach the parent body seeking affiliation after the assembly polls in March 2017."

Velingkar, who was removed from the key post by the RSS on Wednesday, said the workers have "reinstated" him as the Goa "Prant Sangh Chalak."

He was "relieved" from his charge of the state by RSS in the wake of his forum Bharatiya Bhasha Suraksha Manch (BBSM) persistently challenging the BJP and its government in the state as part of its campaign for making the local language Medium of Instruction (MoI) in the schools.

They had even shown black flags to the BJP national chief

Amit Shah during a recent visit to the state. BBMS has been pressing for regional languages like Konkani and Marathi to be made the MoI in schools and grants given to the English-medium institutes stopped.

Sangh said Velingkar was sacked because he was indulging in political activities, which as an RSS member he could not do.

Countering the charge of indulging in politics, he sought to explain as to why the Sangh did not get involved in the assembly election, in which the slogan of "Congress-I

"When they did not object to his involvement in the Congress-hatao, they questioning now speak against BJP?," he said.

PoK would have been ours had we opted for military solution, says Indian Air Force chief

New Delhi, Sept 1: Air chief marshal Arup Raha on Thursday indicated that Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) would have been India's had the country gone for a military solution rather than taking a "moral high ground".

Raha also rued that air power had not been fully utilised by the Indian government till the 1971 Indo-Pak war.

In unusually candid remarks, the Air Force chief termed PoK as a "thorn in our flesh" and said India did not follow a "pragmatic approach" to security needs.

He said India's security environment is vitiated and aerospace power, as part of the military power, would be required to deter a conflict in the region and also ensure peace and tranquillity.

"Our foreign policy was enshrined in the charter of the UN, charter of the Non-Alignment Movement as well as Panchsheel doctrine.

"We have been governed by high ideals and we really did not follow a very pragmatic approach, to my mind, to security needs. To that extent, we did ignore the role of the military power to maintain conducive environment." Raha said at an aerospace seminar here.

He said India as a country was "reluctant" to use military power, especially air power, in deterring adversaries, in deterring a conflict

and when involved in conflict, the country has been drawn several times in the past.

He said when hordes of Chinese attacked Jammu and Kashmir in 1947, it was the transport the IAF which helped Indian soldiers and equipment to the battleground.

"And when a military was in sight, taking me to a peaceful solution to this. The problem still continues, remains a thorn in our day," he said. Raha said in 1962, air power was utilised because of the skirmish.

"In 1965 conflict, we did use air power against East Pakistan because of political reason. Pakistani Air Force operated East Pakistan attacking bases, infrastructure, and ground. We had severe setbacks whenever retaliated," he said.

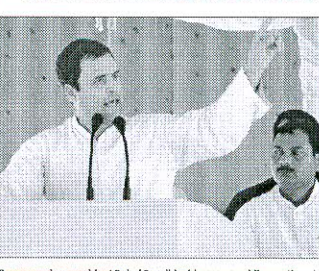

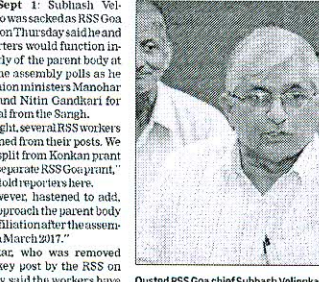

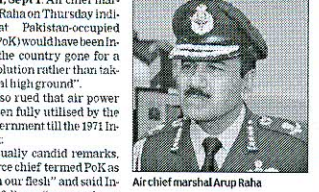

Kejriwal calls sacked minister a 'rotten fish' in AAP

New Delhi, Sept 1: Calling him a "rotten fish", chief minister Arvind Kejriwal on Thursday said Sandeep Kumar was removed from the Delhi Cabinet as he "betrayed" AAP's principles, even as the legislator played the Dalt card to defend himself.

In a video message, Kejriwal positioned AAP as a party with a "difference" and attacked the BJP and Congress for "shielding" top leaders accused of corruption. He also took a "Bangalore edit" swipe at the Prime Minister and BJP chief Amit Shah.

A day after he announced Kumar's sacking on Twitter, Kejriwal asserted that he will prefer

being targeted as part of a "conspiracy" as he was a Dalt and went on to demand a probe into the matter questioning the authenticity of the CD.

Kejriwal said although the turn of events and the fact that "such rotten fishes" were in the party "saddened" him, he takes "pride" from the fact that AAP did not attempt to "cover up" the transgressions.

"Sandeep Kumar betrayed the party, he betrayed the AAP movement and the trust people across the country reposed on AAP. We will never ever compromise on our core values. We will prefer to die, close the party or perish than tolerating wrongdoings," he said.

New Delhi, Sept 1

Rahul Gandhi on Thursday appeared for a defamation case as an accused in a defamation case for his remark against the RSS on the reassignment of Mahatma Gandhi, saying he stood by every word of his statement made during a rally in 2014.

The Congress vice-president expressed his readiness to face a trial after the apex court refused to interfere with criminal proceedings pending against him before a trial court in Maharashtra. Rahul then withdrew the appeal filed by him against the Bombay High Court judgement refusing to quash the defamation case and summons issued to him by the trial court.

The apex court also declined Rahul's plea that he was exempted from personal appearance before the Bhilwari court which has taken cognizance of the complaint of a RSS functionary by summoning him as an accused for his statement on the organisation for the killing of the Father of Nation.

The court's hearing before a bench of justices Dipak Mishra and R Narasimha was the Gandhi case deviating from his earlier stand that he never blamed RSS as an institution for the killing by stating that he stood by every word of his statement made during an election rally in 2014 that had led to the filing of complaint by Sangh functionary Rajesh Mahabud Kante.

"I stand by what I said and every word of my statement. I stand by it yesterday, I stand by it today and I will stand by it in future as well. I am ready to go to the trial," senior advocate Kapil Sibal, appearing for Rahul, submitted, and reiterated "what Gopal Gode's brother Nathuram Gode has said about the RSS."

At the outset, senior advocate U Lalit, who was asked at the last hearing to take instruction from his client as to whether he was ready to accept Rahul's statement that he did not blame RSS but people associated with it for the killing, said there was a need for some addition in the sentence.

"Tom taking the statement at its face value, in the given situation, I can agree with his stand. If every word of my statement is to involve RSS, let him clarify. If he does not intend to involve RSS, let him clarify."

"Let him say that he believes that RSS as an institution was not involved in the killing," Lalit told the bench which had sought his response to the stand taken by the Congress

"For the last 60 years, every time when there is election and whenever it is a political battle and wherever there is minority votes, we (RSS) are the capital hook," Lalit said.

While he was in full swing, senior advocate Sibal interrupted, saying that the opposite side was making a "political speech" and should be stopped.

Lalit shot back saying he will prove the case with proof.

As and the defence levelled, Sibal said that his leader stands by his statement made in the election rally which led to the filing of the private criminal defamation case.

He was "sacked" from his charge of the state by RSS in the wake of his forum Bharathiya Bhaish Suraksha Manch (BBSM) persistently challenging the BJP and its government in the state as part of its campaign for making the state the medium of instruction (MoI) in the schools.

They had even shown black flags to the BJP national chief

Amil Shah during a recent visit to the state. BBSM has been pressing for regional languages like Konkani and Marathi to be made the MoI in schools and grants given to the English-medium institutes stopped.

PoK would have been ours had we opted for military solution, says Indian Air Force chief

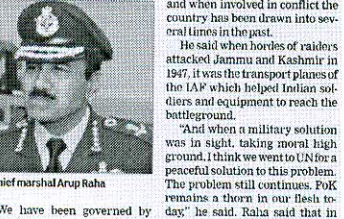
New Delhi, Sept 1: Air chief marshal Arup Raha on Thursday indicated that Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) would have been India's the country gone for a military solution rather than taking a "moral high ground".

Raha also rued that air power had not been fully utilised by the Indian government till the 1971 Indo-Pak war.

In unusually candid remarks, the Air Force chief termed PoK as "a thorn in our flesh," and said India "did not follow a 'pragmatic approach' to security needs."

He said India's security environment is "vulnerable and unresponsive" as part of the military power would be required to deter a conflict in the region and also ensure peace and tranquillity.

"Our foreign policy was enshrined in the charter of the UN, chapter VI of the Non-Aligned Movement as well as Panchshep doctrine."

"We have been governed by high ideals and we really did not follow a very pragmatic approach, in my mind, to security needs. To that extent, we did ignore the role of the military power to maintain conducive environment," Raha said at an aerospace seminar here.

He said India as a country was "reluctant" to use military power, especially air power, in deterring adversaries, in deterring a conflict and when involved in conflict the country has been drawn into several times in the past.

He said when forces of valians attacked Jammu and Kashmir in 1947, it was the transport planes of the IAF which helped Indian soldiers and equipment to reach the battleground.

"And when a military solution was in sight, taking moral high ground, I think we went to UN for a peaceful solution to this problem. The problem still continues. PoK remains a thorn in our flesh today," he said. Raha said that in 1962, air power went under-utilised because of the fear of a skirmish.

"In 1965 conflict, we did not use air power against East Pakistan because of political reasons despite Pakistan Air Force operating from East Pakistan attacking our air bases. Infrastructure, aircraft on ground. We had severe setbacks but we never retaliated," he rued.

Kejri calls sacked minister Bahul prefers to face trial in RSS defamation case

"Sundeep Kumar betrayed the party by betraying the AAP movement and the trust people across the country have reposed on AAP. We will never ever compromise on our principles. We will prefer to die, close the party or perish than tolerating wrongdoings," he said.

Admitting that the case may sully the party's image in people's minds, Kejriwal said the AAP is apart from other parties was that it does not dither to take prompt action on such cases out from the fact that as many as "four people" have been similarly suspended.

New Delhi, Sept 1

RAHUL Gandhi preferred to face a trial in a defamation case for his remark against the RSS on the assassination of Mahatma Gandhi, saying he stood by every word of his statement made during a public rally in 2014.

The Congress vice-president expressed his readiness to face trial after the apex court refused to interfere with criminal proceedings pending against him before a trial court in Maharashtra. Rahul then withdrew the appeal filed in him against the Bombay High Court judgement refusing to quash the information case and summons issued to him by the trial court.

The apex court also declined Rahul's plea that he be exempted from the trial court before the Bhivnandi court which has taken cognizance of the complaint of a RSS functionary by summoning him as an accused person in the case against the organisation for the killing of the Father of Nation.

The trial hearing before a bench of Justices Dipak Misra and R Narasimha Iyer on Monday saw the RSS lawyer state that he never blamed RSS as an institution for the killing but stated that he stood by every word of his statement made during a public rally in 2014 that had led to the filing of a complaint by Sangh functionary Rajesh Mahadev Kunte.

"I stand by each and every word, I will never take my words back. I stood by it yesterday. I stand by it today and I stand by it in the future as well. I am ready to go to the trial," senior advocate Kapil Sibal, appearing for Rahul, submitted, and reiterated "what Gopal Gokhale, brother of Nathuram Godse has said about the RSS."

At the outset, senior advocate R Lalit, who was asked at the last hearing to take instruction from his client as to whether he was ready to accept Rahul's statement that he did not blame RSS but people associated with it for the killing, said there was a need for some addition to his sentence.

"I am taking statement as its face value. In the given situation, I can agree with his stand if he states that he did not intend to involve RSS for the offence. If he says he did not intend to involve RSS, let him clarify."

"Let him say that he believes that RSS as an institution was not involved in the killing," Lalit told the bench which was his response to the stand taken by the Congress

"For the last 60 years, every-time when there is election and wherever it is a political battle and wherever there is minority votes, we (RSS) are the capital hook," Lalit said.

While he was in full swing, senior advocate Sibal interrupted, saying that the opposite side was making a "political speech" and should be stopped.

Lalit then asked Sibal to play the case with proof.

And as the defence lawyer, Sibal said that his client stands by his statement made in the election rally which led to the filing of the private criminal defamation case.

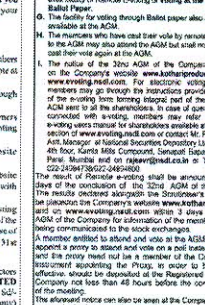
PoK would have been ours had we opted for military solution, says Indian Air Force chief

Admitting that the case may sully the party's image in people's minds, Kejriwal said what sets AAP apart from other parties was that it does not dilute to take prompt action, which comes out from the fact that as many as "four people" have been summarily suspended.

Rahul prefers to face trial in RSS defamation case

New Delhi, Sept 1. Rahul Gandhi on Thursday preferred to face trial as an accused in a defamation case for his remark against the RSS on the assassination of Mahatma Gandhi, saying he stood by every word of his statement made during a rally in 2014.

The Congress vice-president expressed his readiness to face trial after the apex court refused to interfere with criminal proceedings pending against him before a trial court in Maharashtra.

Rahul then withdrew the appeal filed by him against the Bombay High Court judgement refusing to quash the defamation case and summons issued to him by the trial court.

The apex court also declined Rahul's plea that he be exempted from appearing before the Bombay court which has taken cognizance of the complaint of a RSS functionary by summoning him as an accused for his statement on the occasion of the killing of the Father of Nation.

The trial hearing before a bench of Justices Dipak Misra and R Nariman saw the Gandhi side deviating from his earlier stand that he never blamed RSS as an institution for the killing by stating that he stood by every word of his statement made during an election rally in 2014 that had led to the filing of complaint by Sangli functionary Rajesh Mahadev Kunte.

Rahul stood by each and every word, I would not take my words back. I stood by it yesterday. I stand by it today and I will stand by it in future as well. I am ready to go to the trial," senior advocate Kapil Sibal, appearing for Rahul, submitted, and reiterated "what Gopal Godse, brother of Nathuram Godse has said about RSS".

At the outset, senior advocate U RL Lait, who was asked at the last hearing to take instruction from his client as to whether he was ready to accept Rahul's statement that he did not blame RSS but people associated with it for the killing, said there was a need for some addition in the sentence.

"I am taking the statement at its face value. In the given situation, I can agree with his stand by the statement that he did not intend to involve RSS for the killing. If he says he did not intend to involve RSS, let him clarify."

"Let him say that he believes that RSS as an institution was not involved in the killing. Lait told the Bench that he sought his response to the stand taken by the Congress

"For the last 60 years, everytime there is election and whenever it is a political battle and wherever there is minority votes, we (RSS) are the capital hook," Lait said.

While he was in full swing, senior advocate Sibal interrupted, saying that the opposite side was making a "political speech" and should be stopped. Lait shot back saying he will prove the case with proof.

Asked to withdraw the appeal, Sibal said that his leader stands by his statement made in the election rally which led to the filing of the private criminal defamation case.

At this point, the bench stopped the hearing and began dictating the order but Sibal interrupted asking to consider exempting Rahul from personal appearance before the trial court on future dates of hearing.

The bench declined the plea and refused to withdraw the appeal. It said that the sequence of his statement in the election speech is such that RSS is the target.

"Nobody is interested in Godse (Nathuram). He was addressing an election rally and his target was RSS. If he says 'whenever and whenever there is election to target RSS by adding second sentence', Lait, assisted by advocate Anand, said.

"Elaborating further as to how RSS has been under attack of Congress party, Lait said that "whenever and whenever there is an election, RSS is maligning".

"The bench allowed his plea and declared the Special Leave Petition filed by Rahul as 'dismissed as withdrawn'."

The bench also said the trial court would go into the case without being influenced by any of the observations made by the apex court and the High Court during the various hearings before them.

RAHUL Gandhi on Thursday preferred to face trial as an accused in a defamation case for his remark against the RSS on the assassination of Mahatma Gandhi, saying he stood by every word of his statement made during a rally in 2014.

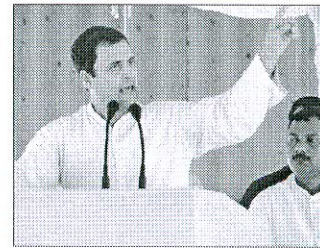
The Congress vice-president expressed his readiness to face trial after the case refused to interfere with criminal proceedings pending against him before a trial court in Maharashtra. Rahul then withdrew the appeal filed by him against the Bombay High Court judgement refusing to quash the defamation case and summons issued to him by the trial court.

The apex court also declined Rahul's plea that he was exempted from personal appearance before the court on grounds which has taken a considerable part of the complaint of a RSS functionary by summoning him as an accused for his statement on the organisation for the killing of the Father of Nation.

The brief hearing before a set of justices Dipak Misra and R.F. Nariman saw the Goan historian deviating from his earlier stand that he never blamed RSS as an institution for the killing by stating that the stand by every word of his statement made during an election rally in 2014.

In 2014, Rahul had led to the filing of a complaint by Sangh functionary Rajesh Mahadev Kunte.

"I stand by each and every word I will never back track. I stood by it yesterday and stand by it today and I

will stand by it in future as well. I am ready to go to the trial," senior advocate Kapil Sibal, appearing for Rahul, submitted, and reiterated "what Gopal Godse, brother of Nathuram Godse has said about the RSS."

At the outset, senior advocate UR Lalit, who was asked at the last hearing to take instruction from his client as to whether he was ready to accept Rahul's statement that he did not blame RSS but people associated with it for the killing, there was a need for some addition to the sentence.

"I am taking the statement at its face value. In the given situation, I can agree with his stand if he states that he did not intend to involve RSS for the offence. If he says he did not intend to involve RSS, let him clarify.

"Lalit says that he believes that RSS as an institution was not involved in the killing." Lalit said the bench which had split on this issue had taken a stand taken by the Congress

"For the last 60 years, everytime when there is election and whenever it is a political battle and wherever there is minority votes, we (RSS) are the capital hook," Lalit said.

While he was in full song, senior advocate Sibal interrupted, saying that the opposite side was making a "political speech" and should be stopped.

Lalit shot back saying he will prove the case with proof.

And as the bench levelled on, Sibal said that his leader stands by his statement made in the election rally which led to the filing of the private criminal defamation case.

At this point, the bench stopped the hearing and began dictating the order but Sibal interrupted asking it to consider exempting Rahul from personal appearance before the trial court on future dates of hearing.

The bench granted the plea saying "we are not granting exemption from personal appearance."

Realising that the bench was not inclined to close the matter by recording the statement of Congress leader, Sibal preferred to withdraw the appeal filed by him against the Bombay High Court judgement refusing to quash the case and summons issued to him by the trial court.

The bench allowed his plea and declared the Special Leave Petition filed by Rahul as "dismissed as well as granting exemption from personal appearance."

The bench also said the trial court would go into the case without being influenced by any of the observations made by the apex court and the High Court during the various hearings before them.

Sacked Goa RSS leader floats parallel unit, blames Parrikar, Gadhikari for action

Panaji, Sept 1: Subhash Velingkar who was sacked as RSS Goa unit chief, on Thursday said he had formed a parallel unit independent of the parent body at least till the assembly polls as he blamed Union ministers Manohar Parrikar and Nitin Gadkari for his removal from the post.

"Last night several RSS workers have resigned from their posts. We are split from Komarpant, forming a separate RSS Group," Velingkar told reporters here.

He, however, hastened to add, "We will approach the parent body seeking affiliation after the assembly polls in March 2017."

Velingkar, who was removed from his post by the RSS on Wednesday, said the workers have "reinstated" him as the Goa "Prant Sangh Chalanak."

He was "relieved" from his state of the state by RSS in the form of his formation. Bhawanrao Bhanusa Surakhsha Manch (BBSM) persistently challenging the BJP and its government in the state as part of its campaign for making the local language Medium of Instruction (MoI) in the schools.

They were sent news black flags to the BJP national chief

Amrit Shah during a recent visit to the state. BBSM has been pressing for regional languages like Konkani and Marathi to be made the MoI in schools and grants given to the English-medium institutes stopped.

Sangh said Velingkar was sacked because he was indulging in political activities, which as an RSS member he could not do.

Countering the charge of meddling in politics, he sought to know as to why the Sangh did not object to his involvement in the political movement during 2012 Goa Assembly election, in which he gave the slogan of "Congress-hatya".

"When they did not object to my role in Congress-hatya, why are they questioning now when I speak against BJP?," he said.

POK would have been ours had we opted for military solution, says Indian Air Force chief

New Delhi, Sept 1: Air chief marshal Arup Raha on Thursday indicated that Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) would have been India's had the country gone for a military solution rather than talking a "moral high ground."

Raha also rued that air power had not been fully utilised by the Indian government till the 1971 Indo-Pak war.

In an unusually candid remark, the Air Force chief termed PoK as a "thorn in our flesh" and said India did not follow a "pragmatic approach" to security needs.

He said India's security environment is vitiated and aerospace power, as part of the military power, would be required to deter conflict in the region and also ensure peace and tranquility.

"Our foreign policy was enshrined in the charter of the UN, charter of the Non-Alignment Movement as well as Panacheel doctrine.

"We have been governed by high ideals and we really did not follow a very pragmatic approach, to my mind, to security needs. To that extent, we did ignore the role of aerospace power in our defence because of a political reason despite Pakistan Air Force operating from East Pakistan attacking our air bases, infrastructure, aircraft on ground. Whodsoever attacks and never retaliated," he rued.

and when involved in conflict the country has been drawn into several times in the past.

He said when hordes of Kashmiri attacked Jammu and Rashid in 1947, it was the transport planes of the IAF which helped Indian soldiers and equipment to reach the battleground.

"And when a military solution was in sight, taking more high ground, I think we went to UN for a peaceful solution to this problem. The problem still exists because remnants of a thorn in our flesh today," he said. Raha said that in 1962, air power went under utilised because of the fear of a skirmish.

"In 1965 conflict, we did not use air power. I think that's because of a political reason despite Pakistan Air Force operating from East Pakistan attacking our air bases, infrastructure, aircraft on ground. Whodsoever attacks and never retaliated," he rued.
