Chennai, Oct 27: AIADMK founder and former Chief Minister M G Ramachandran, fondly known as MGR, has always been an honest man in his entire stint in politics. He grabbed the hearts of people by bringing the nutritious meal scheme. Because of this scheme, many poor children could experience school life who otherwise would have been forced to work. He brought out many welfare measures for the uplift of the downtrodden," said Mylapore MLA R Nataraj. He said this while inaugurating a two-day MGR centenary celebration contests at Dr MGR-Janaki College of Arts and Science here on Thursday. Dr MGR-Janaki College for women correspondent Latha Rajendran, said, 'MGR is well-known as an actor and politician by people of Tamilnadu. We feel happy that the competitions are witnessing enthusiastic participation from students. This is our little attempt towards taking his values to the new generation during his centenary celebrations.' Over 600 students participated in the inaugural day event. The contests are being held in junior, senior and college categories.

Chennai, Oct 27: Indian Coast Guard has completed service of 40 years to the nation, said V S R Murthy, additional director general of Indian Coast Guard. He was speaking at a function at L and T Shipyard at Kattupalli today.

The function was held to launch the offshore patrol vessel (OPV) Vikram built by L and T at Kattupalli shipyard. The vessel was launched by Jyothi Murthy, wife of V S R Murthy.

Coast Guard would continue the service in the years to come and give effective service, he said and added that more ships and aircraft would soon join the fleet. While they have about 130 ships and 32 aircraft, by 2032, they would have 200 ships and 108 aircraft. Currently, about 70 ships are under construction in various parts of this country, he said.

Speaking about Vikram, he said it is a hallmark of indigenisation and a

mark of progress towards the concept of Make in India. The OPV has been built at a cost of Rs 108.6 crore at Kattupalli Shipyard and is the first among the series of seven ships that would soon join the

These would be a replenishment for the decommissioned ships.

Vikram has a length of 98 metres and has a gross tonnage of 2100 tons. It has an endurance of 5,000 nautical miles at a cruising speed of 12 to 14 knots. The maximum speed of the ship is 26 knots.

The ship is likely to be inducted into Coast Guard by April 2018 after completion of extensive sea trials on the fitted equipment.

The subsequent OPVs will be delivered after a span of six months between each OPV, said a Coast Guard official.

The vessel is fitted with state-of-the-art radars, navigation and communication systems which are capable of operating in tropical climate and would be used for day and night surveillance patrol, SAR and pollution response in the exclusive economic zone of India.

Rajain Bargartha, Commander, Coast Guard (eastern region), was among those present.

Cocaine seized at TP Chatram

Chennai, Oct 27: Around 15 kilograms of cocaine was seized from drug peddlers at TP Chatram here last night. A special team headed by Assistant Commissioner of Police Harikumar arrested the accused, Chandrasekar, 23, and Dhanraj, 35 and seized drugs from their possession. It was learnt that the two men obtained the drugs from Andhra Pradesh and were planning to sell at various pockets of the city. Police has launched a search hunt to nab one Loganathan, 30, who is also a key member in the gang. A case has been registered with TP Chatram police station.

Chennai temperature drops

Chennai, Oct 27: As against the forecast that the northeast monsoon will begin by the end of this month, the Met department today said the seasonal rain will start within 24 hours. The department said the rain will be very intense this time with many places receiving above normal showers. An official from the Meteorological Department said, 'Conditions continue to remain favourable for commencement of northeast monsoon rain across Tamilnadu in the next 24 hours. Also, a cyclonic circulation is persisting over southeast Tamilnadu and neighbourhood while a trough is also extending over southeast Bay of Bengal.' 'Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Tamilnadu and Puducherry tomorrow and on Monday. In the last 24 hours, Vailparai recorded a maximum rainfall of 4.06 cm followed by Madurai and Palayamkottai which recorded 2.2 and 2.1 cm each. Coonoor recorded 1.2 cm,' he added. 'In Chennai, maximum and minimum temperatures were 32.1 and 24 degrees Celsius. Relative humidity was quite high at 87 per cent with traces of rainfall. In the next 24 hours, sky condition is likely to be generally cloudy. Rain or thundershowers is likely to occur at some areas,' he said about the city's weather.



As part of monsoon preparedness, a 24/7 emergency call centre has been set up at the Ripon Buildings in Chennai today. As many as 75 officials have been deployed to take charge of the control room.

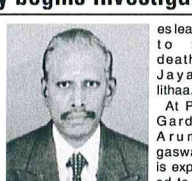
CM opens new police stations

Chennai, Oct 27: Chief Minister Edappadi K Palaniswami inaugurated eight police stations at Ramanaapuram, Tanjavur, Tiruchi, Tuticorin and Virudhunagar via video-conferencing from the Secretariat here today. He also inaugurated three police department buildings in Chennai, Coimbatore and Tiruchi districts and 153 residential quarters for policemen at a cost of Rs 33 crore. Apart from the above, the Chief Minister also inaugurated the barrack constructed for 200 police personnel inside the premises of Nagercoil Armed Forces at a cost of Rs 2.74 crore. At a separate event held at the Chief Minister's special camp office, Palaniswami gave away appointment orders to 100 assistant doctors among the 316 newly appointed doctors by the Medical Recruitment Board of the State.

'Share information on Jaya death'

Arumughaswamy begins investigation from Poes Garden

Chennai, Oct 27: Investigation into the death of former Chief Minister Jayalalithaa began today by the one-man inquiry commission of retired judge A Arumughaswamy. Starting his probe at the famous Poes Garden, where Jayalalithaa resided, he called for people knowing information about Jayalalithaa to provide a statement in a written document on or before 22 November. Speaking to mediapersons, Arumughaswamy said people can reach him personally or can send the information they know through post. He added that people who knew Jayalalithaa well and who were with her can also aid the probe by providing information known to them. Sources said the probe will be completed on time and documents will be handed over for further processes. The inquiry commission was formed by the Tamilnadu government to investigate the circumstances leading to the death of Jayalalithaa. At Poes Garden, Arumughaswamy is expected to find out what happened on the night of 22 September 2016, when the then Chief Minister was rushed to Apollo Hospital. This will include interrogating all those present in the house that night. The investigation will also include getting to know what happened in the hospital on Grems Road. The retired judge is expected to speak to Dr Richard Beale from London and the experts group from AIIMS which oversaw the treatment given to her. Family members of V K Sasikala and top State government officials may also be questioned, sources said.

With just three months given to wrap up the investigation, a lot is riding on the shoulders of the retired judge to complete the investigation on time as expectations and pressure soar high. Close on the heels of Chief Minister Edappadi K Palaniswami's decision to order a probe into the death of the AIADMK supremo, the commission was given a special office at Kalas Mahal. Jayalalithaa died on 5 December last year after 75 days of treatment at Apollo Hospital. Her death and subsequent political developments saw the AIADMK split into two factions with O Panneerselvam, the present Deputy Chief Minister, demanding a probe into her death to bring out the truth. After ousting Sasikala and Dhinakaran from the party, both factions joined hands and Palaniswami ordered a probe into the matter on 25 September. A government order was subsequently passed that said retired judge Arumughaswamy will take charge of the proceedings.

Consultant, Clinical Embryologist, Sperm Donor, Embryo Donor and Egg Donor programmes. He said the hospital would first make the issueless couples understand the nature of problem, explain the modality of treatment after which the treatment would be started and make them become proud parents of a child. The hospital, which has been getting patients from several foreign countries, has offered solutions to thousands of infertility couples through various modes of treatments, he said. With headquartered in Chennai, where it has three centres, the hospital has tied up with Tata Consulting Services in providing treatment through video-conferencing, Lakshman Saravanan said.
