(b) Tightening of norms by European Union for import of shrimp from India.

The Company would like to clarify that there is no specific development now, regarding export of shrimps to European Union. The inspection of 50% of the consignments imported by EU from India which was introduced in 2016 is continuing. The inspection by EU authorities and holding bi-lateral discussions with Indian counterparts i.e., Export Inspection Agency and Export Inspection Council is part of routine process under bi-lateral trade, which takes place periodically. There is no specific impact on export of shrimps to EU.
