Wheat to reach record 98 mt in 2016–17 crop yr

In its second estimate, the agriculture ministry had pegged a record wheat output of 96.64 mt for the current crop year (July-June) as against the actual output of 92.29 mt last year.

"Taking into account the feedback from state governments and experts, it looks like wheat output will reach all-time high of 98 mt this year," a senior agriculture official told ministry reporters on the sidelines of a two-day annual kharif conference.

Meanwhile, agriculture minister Radha Mohan Singh said the government has set foodgrain output target at record 273 million tonne for the 2017-18 crop year and expects to achieve four per cent farm sector growth following the prediction of normal monsoon.

Foodgrain production is estimated to touch a record 271.98 million tonne (mt) in the current year (July-June) on account of good rains after two years of drought, accordis being harvested in full ing to the second estimate of the agriculture ministry.
