ICAI sets up GST helpdesks

New Delhi, May 29

Chartered accountants' apex body ICAI has set up desks to help small businessmen and traders on Goods and Services Tax (GST), which is set to be rolled out from July 1. ICAI GST Sahayata Desks have been made operational, without any charge, at all major cities to facilitate small businessmen, traders, shopkeepers and public at large. The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) said these desks would be made operational at around 200 locations in different part of the country. Among others, these desks would create basic awareness on GST, inform individuals about the benefits and help them in migration to the new system. PTI

Jaitley to sign OECD tax pact

Finance Minister Arun Jaitley will travel to Paris next week to sign the OECD multilateral convention that aims to check crossborder tax evasion by multinational companies. During his three-day visit beginning June 7, Jaitley will also attend the OECD Ministerial Council meeting, in which ministers from the OECD and partner countries will discuss issues of global relevance. The Union Cabinet had earlier this month approved signing of the multilateral convention of the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD). The convention is an outcome of the OECD-G20 BEPS project to tackle base erosion and profit shifting (BEPS) which is resorted to by MNCs through tax planning strategies by exploiting gaps and mismatches in tax rules. No room for revising GST rates: CBEC chief

GST will make India a tax-compliant society: Jaitley

engaluru, May 29 "There is no room for revising Goods and Services Tax (GST) rates fixed on various goods and services," said Vanaja Sarna, Chairperson, Central Board of Excise and Customs (CBEC).

"The GST Council is meeting on June 3 to fix rates for goods which have been left out.

"Revision of rates may come up, but chances of that happening are remote," she told reporters on the sidelines of National Academy of Customs, Indirect Taxes and Narcotics (NACIN) facility inauguration.

Acknowledging that CBEC is getting representations, Sarna said, "We have got and keep getting numerous representations from industries and businesses. The Governing Council will take the final decision when it meets on June 3."

She further said, "At this stage, it will be very difficult to say if the Council will actually reopen any of the rates because of the time factor involved in bringing out the GST.

"One must remember, if you open up any of these, then there will be no stop to revisionary demands."

Sarna said even though an anti-profiteering agency has not been set up to curb industry taking undue advantage to create arbitrage before the rollout of GST on July 1, the government

will have the rights to question arbitrary hikes in prices.

"The anti-profiteering agency is yet to be set up, but we will have all the rights to question the industry against hiking prices arbitrarily," she said.

Earlier in the day, Finance Minister Arun Jaitley, speaking after

inaugurating Academy of Customs, Indirect Taxes and Narcotics (NACIN) facility, said "GST regime will make India more tax-complaint society."

Training academies like NACIN are crucial for a tax-complaint society as it forges a proper co-ordination between taxation authorities (Centre and state governments) and the tax payer. The amalgamation of various indirect taxes is itself a monumental taxation change, which requires officials to upgrade their skills and knowledge, Jaitley said.

New complex

NACIN, Bengaluru, established in 2002 for training officers of the Customs, Central Excise and Service Tax posted in Karnataka and Kerala, has moved into the new complex constructed at a cost of ₹49 crore.

The training facility is expected to train the officers of Central Board of Excise and Customs and officers of the VAT Department in the new GST regime.

According to DP Nagendra Kumar, Principal Additional Director-General of Central Excise,

Listing out some of its employment-related initiatives, the Ministry said: "Over 3.87 crore candidates, 14.8 lakh establishments are registered on the NCS (National Career Services) Portal... around 540 job fairs were organised in

Among the other initiatives, an official release by the Ministry said it had inked strategic memoranda of understanding with leading job portals, placement organisa-

tions and institutions of repute.

"Government of India has recently made it mandatory for government vacancies to be posted on the NCS Portal. The NCS project also involves setting up of 100 Model Career Centres to deliver quality employment services and these centres are being set up in collaboration with States and in-

stitutions," the release said. The other "path breaking initiatives/decisions" by the Ministry include legislative and administrative reforms, effective compliance and 'ease of doing business' and delivery of social security services through better use of technology, the release added.

The legislative initiatives in-

clude the Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Amendment Act, 2016, which came into force from September 2016, the Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Act, 2017 that comes into force from April 2017, enhancing leave to 26 weeks, the Payment of Wages (Amendment) Act, 2017, enabling employers to pay wages by cash or cheque or crediting it to employee bank accounts, the Employee Compensation (Amendment) Bill 2016 to rationalise penalties, Payment of Bonus Amendment Act, 2015 that envisages enhancement of eligibility limit under to₹21,000/month, among others.

The industrial climate also improved, said the Ministry, adding that up to March 2017, a total of 7,333 disputes were settled, compared with 6,692 in 2015-16 and 6,376 in 2014-15.

10 waterways to be made operational next year: Gadkari

Cabinet approved ₹2,000 crore for waterways development last week

New Delhi, May 29 Having secured ₹2.000 crore from a central fund for development of water transport, operationalising at least 10 of the 111 National Waterways next year is on the top of government's agenda, Union Minister Nitin Gadkari has

said. The government last week approved allocation of 2.5 per cent of the Central Road Fund (CRF) for NWs that would result in about ₹2,000 crore proceeds a year for their development.

"The Cabinet has approved ₹2,000 crore from CFR and we can easily get works done worth ₹12,000 crore from that by raising more funds. It is my endeavour to operation-

alise 10 waterways before December 2018," the Shipping. Road Transport and Highways Minister told PTI in an interview.

Massive work worth ₹5,000 crore is already underway on Ganga (1.620 km) with World Bank assistance which is the National Waterway No 1. The work includes develop-

ment of three multi-modal hubs at Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh, Haldia in West Bengal and Sahebganj in Bihar.

The Inland Waterways Authority of India, under the Shipping Ministry, is also facilitating cruise operations on NW-1 from Kolkata to Varanasi in collaboration with private cruise operators.

Gadkari said that apart from Ganga, development of

NW-2 which is Brahmaputra (890 km stretch) is also top on agenda government. "After

Ganga Brahmaputra, work will begin on Mandavi and Zuari in next three months," he said. The third project will be Amba and then on Brahmani river between Talcher and

Paradip. The Shipping Ministry has a target to start work on 24 NWs in the next three years.

GDP growth may be revised

Parliament last year had enacted National Waterways Act, 2016, for developing and maintaining the existing five NWs and 106 new NWs across the country.


The Cabinet earlier this month has approved allocation of 2.5 per cent of CRF which is a duty on excise and customs imposed on petrol and high speed diesel for waterways development. The cess at present is ₹6 per litre.

It has also directed that while implementing viable NW projects, all such components that can be done on PPP basis, should be explored and government funding may be used only if private investment is not forthcoming. A sum of ₹80,800 crore was

collected CRF in 2016-17, ₹69.540 crore in 2015-16 and ₹25,122 crore in 2014-15.

The Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) has es-

timated that approximately ₹25,000 crore would be required for development of identified projects on NWs till 2022-23.



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

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Stalled projects: NIIF may meet bankers this week PRESS TRUST OF INDIA New Delhi, May 29

The National Investment and Infrastructure Fund (NIIF) is likely to meet bankers this week to examine if it can extend last-mile funding to stalled infrastructure projects that have turned toxic for want of funds.

The last-mile funding will help get them off the ground, said a senior Finance Ministry official.

"We have brokered a meeting between bankers and the NIIF recently. The NIIF could finance some of the projects that have turned into NPAs due to increased costs, among other reasons, and cannot access bank credit for last-mile funding," the official said.

According to CMIE data, implementation of projects that collectively envisaged investments worth ₹77,700 crore was stalled during the December 2016 quarter.

This is 38 per cent higher than the value of projects stalled during the preceding (September 2016) quarter. It is also more than 10 per cent higher than the average value of projects getting halted mid-way through their implementation during the past year, it said, adding that the problem continues to plague investments in India.

'Tough call for RBI'
