We have audited the accompanying statement of quarterly standalone financial results of CEAT Limited ('the Company') for the quarter ended March 31, 2017 and for the year ended March 31, 2017, attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, read with SEBI Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016. The quarterly standalone financial results are the derived figures between the audited figures in respect of the year ended March 31, 2017 and the published year-to-date figures up to December 31, 2016, being the date of the end of the third quarter of the current financial year, which were subjected to limited review. 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



The company's investment in joint venture in Sri Lanka is accounted using the equity method, which hitherto, under the erstwhile Indian Generally Accepted Principles, was consolidated using proportionate consolidation method.
- 3. The figures of the last quarter are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year upto March 31, 2017/ March 31, 2016 and the unaudited published year to date figures up to December 31, 2016/ December 31, 2015 being the date of third quarter of financial year, which was subjected to limited review.


- 8. As the Company's business activity falls within a single operating segment, viz. "Tyres", no separate segment is disclosed.
