

AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Members of Vision Corporation Limited

Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Vision Corporation Limited ("the Company"), which comprise the balance sheet as at 31 March 2017, the statement of profit and loss for the quarter and year then ended and the cash flow statement of the Company for the year then ended and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.
