We have audited the accompanying Statement of Consolidated Financial Results of FOODS AND INNS LIMITED ("the Company"), its subsidiaries (the Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group") and its associate for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2017 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation 2015. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's management and reviewed by the Audit Committee, at its meeting held on May 10, 2017 and approved by the Board of Directors, at its meetings held on May 11, 2017, has been prepared on the basis of the related consolidated financial statements of the Company which is in accordance with the Accounting Standards prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014 and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Statement based on our audit of such consolidated financial statements.
- 2. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountant of India. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Statement is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and the disclosures in the Statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatements in the accompanying Statement, whether due to fraud or error. 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at March 31, 2017, total revenues of Rs.4159.02 Lacs, total profit after tax of Rs. (67.71) Lacs as also net cash outflow of Rs.19.09 Lacs for the year ended March 31, 2017, as considered in the consolidated financial results. These financial statements have been audited by other auditors whose report have been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion on the Statement, is in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries and associates, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors.

Our opinion is not qualified in respect of this matter.

- 4. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, and based on the consideration of the reports of the other auditors on separate financial statements and other financial information of the subsidiaries and associates referred to in paragraph 3 above, the Statement:
 - a. includes the financial results for the year ended March 31, 2017 of the following entities:

- i. Pharmpak Private Limited
- ii. F.N.I. Asia Private Limited

- i. Finns Frozen Foods (I) Limited

- 5. In the Statement, the figures of the financial results as reported for the quarter ended March 31, 2017 and March 31, 2016 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures upto the end of the third quarter of the relevant financial year. Also, the figures upto the end of the third quarter had only been subjected to limited review by us and had not been subjected to audit.

Emphasis of matter

As regards Consolidated Financial Results, we draw attention to:

a. the fact that the preparation of the results of F.N.I. Asia Pte. Ltd., the wholly owned subsidiary, is on a going concern basis despite its total current liabilities exceeded total current assets. A material uncertainty exists that may cast significant doubt on the Company's ability to continue as a going concern. The ability of the said subsidiary to continue depends on the Company undertaking to provide continuing

financial support to the enable the said subsidiary to continue as a going concern. The directors are satisfied the financial support will be available when required.

b. to the fact that the preparation of the results of Finns Frozen Foods (I) Limited ("Finns"), the Company's associate, is on a going concern basis despite the erosion in its net worth. The appropriateness of the going concern assumption in the associate is dependent on the said associate's ability to establish consistent profitable operations as well as raising adequate finance to meet its short term and long term obligations. Based on the mitigating factors, as per the management of the associate, it is believed that the going concern assumption in the financial statements of the associate is appropriate and no adjustment is required in the financial statements for the year ended March 31, 2017.

Our Opinion is not qualified in respect of the above matters.
