Dear Members,

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act"), read with the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (including any statutory modification or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force), that the resolutions appended below are proposed to be passed by the Members through postal ballot/electronic voting (e-voting). The explanatory statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 pertaining to the said resolutions setting out the material facts concerning each item and the reasons thereof, is annexed hereto with a Postal Ballot Form for your consideration.

The Board of Directors of the Company ("Board") in its meeting held on August 2, 2017 has appointed CS Piyush Bindal, Practicing Company Secretary, Proprietor of "M/s Piyush Bindal & Associates", Company Secretaries, Bhopal (Membership No. FCS 6749; CP No. 7442), to act as the Scrutiniser ("Scrutiniser ") for conducting the postal ballot process in a fair and transparent manner.

The Members are requested to carefully read the instructions printed in the Postal Ballot Form, record their assent (for) or dissent (against) therein and return the same duly completed in all aspects in the enclosed Self-addressed Business Reply Envelope. Postage will be borne and paid by the Company. Postal Ballot Form(s), if sent by courier/registered post/speed post at the expense of the Member(s) will also be accepted. The Postal Ballot Forms may also be deposited personally at the address mentioned on the Business Reply Envelope. The duly completed Postal Ballot Form(s) should reach the Scrutiniser not later than 5.00 p.m. IST on September 11, 2017. If Postal Ballot Form is received after the said time, it shall be considered as invalid.

In cases, where the Postal Ballot Form has been signed by an authorised representative of a body corporate, a certified true copy of the relevant authorisation to vote on the postal ballot, should also accompany the postal ballot form.

In compliance with Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations") and pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Act, read with rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, the Company is pleased to provide e-voting facility to all its members, to enable them to cast their votes electronically instead of dispatching the physical postal ballot form(s) by post. Shah in Karn, declares Ab Ki Baar, BJP Sarkar

Bengaluru

Sounding the poll bugle in Karnataka, BJP president Amit Shah on Saturday kicked off his visit to the state, declaring that the party stands united and said 'Ab Ki Baar, BJP Sarkar' (This time, a BJP government).

Shah, who is in Karnataka on a 3-day visit to re-energise a faction-riven state unit, asserted that the party was ready for the electoral battle to win the assembly polls under the leadership of BJP state unit chief BS Yeddyurappa.

"Friends, our party stands united, and is geared up to take to the electoral battlefield under the leadership of Yeddyurappa in coming days, and see to it that we form a BJP government in the state," Shah told party workers near the Kempe Gowda International Airport here.

Assembly polls in Karnataka are due early next year for which the party has a 150-plus seats goal to come back to power. Shah is scheduled to interact with partymen at various levels and expected to give a pep talk to senior leaders to remain united, as the open bickerings between some of its leaders until recently had embarrassed the party.

Yeddyurappa has come under criticism from a section of partymen over his alleged "arbitrary style" of functioning with another senior leader K S Eshwarappa openly flagging the issue until both were told to shun open display of differences.

"I am hopeful that the way the party, for the last five years, has been fighting against the corrupt, oppressive and polarising rule of the Congress, the people of this great state of Karnataka have decided to vote the BJP to power," Shah said.



Addressing the party workers who gave him a rousing reception near the airport, Shah said he had come here to realise the goal of forming the next BJP government in Karnataka.

"I have come here amidst BJP workers to realise 'Ab Ki Baar, BJP Sarkar' (This time, a BJP government) resolution," he added. He said when Prime Minister Narendra Modi's 'Vijay Rath' (victory chariot) would reach Karnataka in next February-March, party workers should be ready with their quest to make inroads into the southern India by winning Karnataka.

Amit Shah invites Nitish Kumar to join NDA

New Delhi: BJP president Amit Shah has invited Bihar CM Nitish Kumar to join the ruling NDA, following the latter's alliance with the saffron party in the state to form a new government. "I met JDU president Nitish Kumar at my residence on Friday. I invited JDU to join the NDA," Shah said in a tweet on Saturday. The Bihar-based party is expected to endorse a proposal to join the NDA in its national executive meeting in Patna on August 19, after which it is likely to join the Narendra Modi cabinet.

Sena minister Desai offers to quit, CM declines request

Mumbai

Shiv Sena Minister Subhash Desai, accused of graft by the Opposition, on Saturday offered to resign, but Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis turned down his request. The development comes a day after Fadnavis announced a probe by Lokayukta against Housing Minister Prakash Mehta, who has been accused by the opposition of impropriety in a slum redevelopment project here. He belongs to the BJP.

The opposition has accused Desai of violating norms while allegedly denotifying lands acquired by state-run MIDC in Nashik. On allegations against Desai, Fadnavis had yesterday said the government will request the Lokayukta to consider the case and if that does not work out, an independent probe would be conducted. The 75-year-old Sena veteran, who holds the industries portfolio, said he met Fadnavis and offered to quit the state cabinet, but his request was rejected by the chief minister. "I met the chief minister at 'Varsha' (the CM's official residence) with my resignation letter and requested him to relieve me until I am proved innocent. However, the chief minister refused to accept my resignation and said I need not resign," Desai told PTI.

AIADMK factions to unite soon: TN ministers

Coimbatore

Two senior Tamil Nadu ministers on Saturday exuded confidence that AIADMK factions, one led by Chief Minister K Palaniswami and the other by his predecessor O Panneerselvam, will soon come together and the government would complete its full five-year term.

"What is going on at present is disagreement between brothers, which will be settled amicably at the earliest," Forest Minister Dindigul Srinivasan told reporters here. Separately, Cooperation Min-

ister Sellur L Raju said that "we will work together to fulfil the dreams of former chief minister J Jayalalithaa".

The process of merger of the two factions is going on for the last seven months and the days were not far for them to coming together, Srinivasan said.

"The present government would complete its full term," he added. About Dhinakaran, nephew of jailed party general secretary VK Sasikala, reportedly calling chief minister E K Palaniswami a '420' (used to refer to people who cheat), Srinivasan said it could have been

due to a slip of tongue, as he had clarified later and there was no need to play it up further.

However, the minister said he was not aware of Palaniswami calling Dhinakaran a '420'. To a question on reports of O Panneerselvam becoming the deputy chief minister, Srinivasan said it had come out in some sections of the press. Any fact would be revealed by Palaniswami, as both the party and government are working under him, he said. "His opinion is my opinion."

Stalin fishing in troubled waters: BJP on his 'no-trust motion'

Chennai

The BJP on Saturday attacked DMK leader MK Stalin over his announcement of moving a no-confidence motion against the AIADMK government saying he is "trying to fish in troubled waters". In the backdrop of likely merger of two AIADMK factions after the removal of TTV Dhinakaran as AIADMK (Amma) deputy general secretary, Stalin had said on Friday DMK would move a no-confidence motion against the government "if required".

Centre urged to initiate talks to end Darjeeling imbroglio

Darjeeling

The Gorkhaland Movement Coordination Committee (GMCC) today urged the Centre to initiate a dialogue with all stakeholders to restore normalcy in Darjeeling hills, where an indefinite shutdown entered its 59th day. The shutdown in the hills will continue until and unless a "positive step" is taken to restore normalcy by the Centre, GMCC, apex body of 30 hill parties participating in the stir for a separate Gorkhland, stated at an emergency meeting at Kalimpong.

"We urge the Central Government to initiate a dialogue process so that normalcy can be restored in the hills. If the state government is part of that process, we have no problems," GMCC convenor Kalyan Dewan told PTI after the meeting. The committee condemned the recent arrests made by

police and the area domination marches in the hills during the past few days.

Asked whether any decision had been taken on relaxing the shutdown on Independence Day, Dewan said, "It will be decided very soon after discussing it with all the hill parties and GJM president Bimal Gurung. But the people of the hills are patriots and we will celebrate Independence here. Every household will hoist the national flag and we will take out rallies carrying the tricolor".

Sources said sharp differences have cropped up between Gorkha Janamukti Morcha and other hill parties in the GMCC over continuing the shutdown. Parties like Jan Andolan Party of Harka Bahadur Chhetri which had earlier thrown its weight behind the protest and others are now in favour of withdrawing the shutdown in the hills, sources said.

Rahul: Modi govt making hollow promises

Raichur (Ktk)

Congress vice president Rahul Gandhi on Saturday hit out at the Modi government over farmer and unemployment issues, accusing it of making "hollow" and "false" promises. "We don't make big promises; rather we will perform and show.

When Modi's government came, farmers were promised full help, but across the country farmers are committing suicide," Gandhi said. He said in Karnataka and Punjab, Congress govts had stood by the farmers. "Wherever there is Congress party government, you will see them standing with farmers, because we understand that farmers make India strong. Claiming that Advani as Home Minister was against Article 371 (J), he said after Congress came to power in 2004, the special status was granted

Barala, friend sent to JC till Aug 25

Haryana BJP chief Subhash Barala's son Vikas and his friend Ashish Kumar were on Saturday sent to the judicial custody till August 25 by a court here in the alleged stalking and attempt to abduction case of a 29-year-old woman. Amid tight police security, both were presented before the court of duty magistrate Gaurav Dutta. Defence counsel Surya Prakash said: "Both the youths have been sent to 14 days of judicial custody". They had been earlier sent to the police remand for two days till August 12.

two accused were re-arrested on August 9 after they joined the police investigation and charged with attempted abduction under section 365 of the IPC and section 511, which relates to an attempt to commit an offence punishable with life or other imprisonment. Police reconstructed the 'crime' scene on August 10 -- six days after the incident took place -- in connection with the stalking and attempt to abduction incident.

The defence lawyer had earlier claimed that Vikas (23) and Ashish (27) had not committed any offence and said that a "media trial" was going on in the case.
