- I, Mrs. Grishma Khandwala, Company Secretary in Practice have been appointed as the scrutinizer of P.H. CAPITAL LIMITED pursuant to Section 108 and Section 109 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 and Rule 21 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, and pursuant to Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 for the purpose of:
- (i) Scrutinizing the remote e-voting process under the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and pursuant to Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, and
- (ii) Scrutinizing the poll process under the provisions of Section 109 of the Act, 2013 read with Rule 21 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, conducted for passing the resolutions contained in the Notice convening the 44th AGM of the Equity Shareholders of the Company held on Thursday, 28th September, 2017 at 12.00 noon. at The Chancellor Hall, The National Sports Club Of India, Lala Lajpat Rai Marg, Worli, Mumbai 400 018.

The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules relating to voting by electronic means and poll for the resolutions contained in the Notice of the 44th AGM of the Equity Shareholders dated 11th August, 2017. My responsibility as a Scrutinizer for the remote e-voting process and for polling process is restricted to making a Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast "in favour" or "against" the resolutions stated in the notice of the AGM, based on the reports generated from the remote e-voting system provided by Central Depository Services Limited (CDSL), the Agency authorised under the Rules and engaged by the Company to provide e-voting facilities for voting through remote e-voting and based on the physical votes cast by ballot by Members/Proxies at the AGM.

The Notice dated 11th August, 2017 convening the AGM was sent to the shareholders in respect of the below mentioned resolutions to be passed at the AGM of the Equity Shareholders of the Company.

The Company had availed the remote e-voting facility offered by Central Depository Services Limited (CDSL) for facilitating remote e-voting to the shareholders of the Company and had also provided poll voting process to the shareholders who attended the AGM and who had not voted electronically.

The Shareholders of the Company holding shares of the Company as on the "cutoff" date of 21st September, 2017 were entitled to vote on the resolutions as contained in the Notice of AGM of the Company.

The period for remote e-voting commenced on Monday 25th September, 2017 at 9.00 a.m. and ended on Wednesday 27th September, 2017 at 5.00 p.m.

On 27th September, 2017, after the end of the remote e-voting period i.e. 27th September, 2017, at 5.00 p.m., I was provided access to details of the members who had opted for e-voting. The details such as the name of the member, folio no. and number of shares held by the member could be seen to ensure that these members do not vote again at the AGM. However the manner in which the votes were cast by the members were not available.

Further, the Chairman announced that facility for voting through ballot paper was available at the AGM venue for the shareholders who attended the meeting and had not cast their vote earlier through remote e-voting.

The voting results were diligently scrutinized and were reconciled with the records maintained by Bigshare Services Private Limited, Registrar and Transfer Agent of the Company and the authorisations/proxies lodged with the Company.

I have scrutinized and reviewed the remote e-voting and votes tendered therein based on the data downloaded from the e-voting website of CDSL and also the voting results during the poll process at the AGM.
