Govt's move to allow 100% FDI triggers multiple responses Cabinet takes key decisions ahead of budget

Chennai, Jan 11:

The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has given its approval to a number of amendments in the FDI Policy. It aims to provide ease of doing business in the country which in turn will lead to larger FDI inflows contributing to growth of investment, income and employment. This is the second major liberalisation in FDI policy by the NDA government in one go after major changes effected in June 2016. Here are the major decisions:

CENT PER CENT

In a move that will give a boost to foreign retailers like Ikea, Walmart and Carrefour, the Cabinet approved 100 per cent FDI under the automatic route for single brand retail trading. Earlier also 100 per cent FDI was allowed in the segment, but it required government approval.

IN THE AIR

Cabinet has allowed foreign airlines to now open up to 49 per cent stake in national carrier Air India. While allowing foreign air- lines to have stake in Air In- dustry, the government has also made the national carrier's ownership would remain Indian nationals. Air India had a total debt of about Rs 17,360 crore as of March 2017, of which about Rs 17,360 crore was aircraft loan and Rs 31,577 crore was work- debt. The airline is expected to report a net loss of Rs 3,579 crore for 2017-18, as per budget estimates for 2017-18. It had a provisional net loss of Rs 3,643 crore in 2016-17.

WHAT ELSE?

The Cabinet has relaxed foreign direct investment (FDI) policy for medical devices and audit firms associated with companies receiving overseas funds. Overseas investment policy has also been liberalised in case of power exchanges. Currently, the policy provides for 49 per cent FDI under automatic route in power exchanges. However, FDI/FPI purchases were restricted to secondary market only. Cabinet has decided to do away with this provision, thereby allowing FDI/FPIs to invest in Power Exchanges through primary market as well. Cabinet has approved liberalisation in the construction development segment clarifying that real-estate broking service does not amount to

real estate business and is therefore, eligible for 100 per cent FDI under automatic route.

Commenting on the development, Commerce and Industry Minister Suresh Prabhu said the decisions would help 'remove roadblocks' for receiving foreign investments. The minister expressed the hope that relaxation of norms would facilitate faster development of the economy. "The move will not only attract additional foreign capital into the country, but will also provide an impetus to the retail industry growth, at a time when organised and retail is already seeing strong growth over the last 12 months."

Commenting on the development, Abhishek Goenka, leader-direct tax, PwC India, said the clarification was long overdue. J.L. India, CEO and country head, Ramesh Nair, said the opening up of FDI for real estate broking is a strong signal of institutionalisation of the services rendered towards real estate in India.

"NOT WORTH" Foreign direct investment (FDI) is not worth much unless there is technology transfer, senior BVP leader Subramanian Swamy said. He said foreign investment contributes only 2 per cent to India's investments and unless accompanied by technological transformation, it is not of much use for the economy.

'10% salary hike' Cos to increase headcount and pay across all biz, says report

Salaries are expected to grow by 10 per cent across industries and career levels as organisations are likely to increase headcount this year, says a report. According to Mercer's 2017 India Total Remuneration Survey, companies are likely to dole out 10 per cent salary increase across industries in 2018, consistent with 2016 and 2017. The survey of 791 organisations across industry sectors found that 55 per cent companies intend to hire in the next 12 months, as against 48 per cent last year. 'Indian industry continues to project low double digit increases, driven by a combination of an optimistic economic environment and a scarcity of the right talent,' said Mercer, India business leader, talent consulting and information solutions, Shanthi Naresch. One in two companies are planning to increase headcount, with shared services and Hi-tech leading the pack, similar to what was seen in the past two years, the survey said. 'In the shared services sector, there is an influx of captive organisations across retail, FMCG, manufacturing and pharmaceuticals. Newer roles are emerging in supply chain planning, analytics, demand planning, computer imagery, store design, merchandising etc. With the evolution in value chain of work and the advent of such transformational roles, companies are looking at increasing headcount,' Naresch added.

'Job, farm, exports are focus areas'

New Delhi, Jan 11 (PTI):

Job creation, doubling farmers' income, boosting manufacturing and promoting exports were the key themes that came up for discussion during an interactive session between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and economists. Briefing reporters about the meeting, Niti Aayog vice-chairman Rajiv Kumar said over 40 economists and experts shared insightful views on various aspects relating to the economy and policy-making. One of the experts, he said, was of the opinion that the government should target only job growth and stressed on high economic expansion for generating employment. Another expert pointed out that more than 20 per cent educated youth were unemployed. Kumar further said the Niti Aayog will 'very soon' come out with a report of the task force, which was set up to study high frequency data on job creation. "There is a much better news on employment" contrary to the data provided by labour bureau and the Centre for Monitoring Indian Economy (CMI).

Is it really SMART?

Only 5% finished so far in govt's mission of modern city

New Delhi, Jan 11: The Narendra Modi government's flagship Smart City mission is running at a very slow pace with only 5.2 per cent of the total identified projects being completed in the last two years, a newspaper report has said. Under the Smart City Mission, 90 cities have so far been identified through three rounds of competition for implementing various projects. A total investment of Rs 1.91 lakh crore has been proposed by these 90 cities. The media report said that the identified projects have been completed with just 1.4 per cent of the total envisaged investment. As per the mission statement and guidelines, the duration of the mission is five years, from 2015-16 to 2019-20 and each city will get Rs 500 crore as central assistance for implementing various projects.

YET TO BE PREPARED

About 72 per cent of the identified projects are still at the stage of preparation of detailed project report. The New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) has completed maximum number of smart city projects. NDMC leads the chart with 23 completed projects, Varanasi has completed 16 projects and Raipur has finished 10 project. Twenty-seven cities have not issued a single tender for works to be carried out under the mission, TOI said.

However, according to an official Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry statement, Union Minister Hardeep Singh Puri has recently informed a Parliamentary consultative committee that projects worth Rs 1,35,459 crore are in various stages of implementation, 147 projects worth Rs 1,872 crore have been completed, it added. Puri said the implementation of the mission is done by a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) to be set up at city-level in the form of a limited company and are promoted by the State/UT and the Urban Local Body (ULB) jointly both having 50:50 equity shareholding. So far 77 smart cities have established their SPVs, he informed.

Not so good, says Knight Frank

Chennai, Jan 11:

Knight Frank India launched the eighth edition half yearly report - India Real Estate, which "presents an analysis of residential and office market performance of Chennai for the period July-December 2017". Speaking about the findings, director, Kanchana Krishnan, said, "After showing signs of a promising recovery during H1 2017, Chennai residential market once again hit new lows in terms of sales and supply numbers during H2 2017. The lack lustre demand scenario in addition to the implementation of the Real Estate Regulation Act and GST Act led to a 33 per cent Yo-Y drop in new projects in H2 2017. This brought down the annual supply number under 10,000 units for the first time during this decade."

"The residential market also witnessed a drop of 89 per cent and 56 per cent in the half yearly launches and sales respectively, from the peak levels during H1 2011. Developers focusing on offloading existing inventories during H2 2017 by re-launching old products at lower prices and smaller configurations wherever possible has resulted in a reduction the average asking price by 3 per cent," she added. Chennai office market continued to be plagued by an acute shortage of visible and godduality office stock resulting in a 17 per cent Yo-Y decline in transactions volume during H2 2017 and 12 per cent decline for the entire year, the release added.
