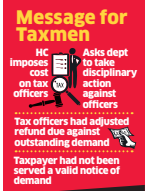
BOMBAY HC RULING

I-T Officers Told to Pay Up for Adjusting Refund Against Dues

₹1.5 lakh was adjusted without serving a notice of demand

New Delhi: The Bombay High Court instructed the Income tax department in a recent case to recover ₹1.5 lakh from tax officers for adjusting refund of the amount due to a taxpayer against outstanding demands without first ensuring that a valid notice of demand was served on the taxpayer.

cost of ₹1.5 lakh to be paid to the taxpayer. Based on the taxpayer's records available with the tax officer for assessment years 1985-86, 2003-04, 2006-07 and 2012-13, the tax officer had observed that the demands for those years were outstanding. The tax officer then adjusted the refund due to the taxpayer for certain other assessment years against the outstanding demand.

The taxpayer said he had not received the order pertaining to the demands and argued that the adjustment against the refund by the tax officer was therefore invalid. "This is one of the rare cases where the court has imposed a penalty on the tax officials, and asked tax administration to review its internal functioning and take necessary action," said Vikas Vasal, National leader tax, Grant Thornton India LLP.

"Probably it's also a reflection of the changing society that has its expectations rising from the government and its administrative machinery to deliver services in a fair and just manner."

Prabhu Seeks Higher Sops to Push Farm, Services Exports

New Delhi: Commerce and industry minister Suresh Prabhu has written to finance minister Arun Jaitley seeking higher export incentives to promote trade of agricultural products under the Merchandise Exports from India Scheme (MEIS) as well as additional outlay for a scheme to boost services exports whose growth has slowed in the current fiscal.

introduce a 10% incentive on rice exports, commensurate with rise in minimum support price to make the commodity competitive in global markets. For making customs duty payment, importers can use MDIS scrips, which ET has seen.

Prabhu writes to Jaitley asking for extra outlay to boost trade. The commerce department has also requested for incentives on all meals to be hiked to 10%, as currently it is allowed only on soy meals.

"This is required in view of competitive disadvantages faced by our exporters vis-à-vis exporters of competing countries having free/preferential trade agreements with many importing countries," as per the letter, which ET has seen. For the services sector, Prabhu has requested an enhancement in allocation to ₹10,000 crore from the current allocation of ₹2,600 crore to push its growth to double-digits in view of "creeping protectionism globally and trade tensions among major economies like the US, China and the EU". Services exports grew 6.1% in 2017 and 10.1% in 2017-18. However, in the April-June quarter of the current fiscal, the growth has only been 4.9%.

ET Q&A CHRISTINE LAGARDE MD, INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND

'De-escalate, Fix Global Trade, Don't Destroy It'

Christine Lagarde, managing director of the International Monetary Fund, told ET Now's Surjya Shrinete in Bali that she hopes global trade tensions will ease. Markets plunged across the world on Thursday, sparked by a crash in US equities owing to worries over the escalating trade war. Lagarde, who was in the Indonesian island to attend the annual meetings of the IMF and World Bank Group, also said now is the time to prepare for monetary tightening as the US economy picks up. Edited excerpts:



INDIA'S VULNERABILITY The fact that India is dependent on imported oil, and prices are going up at the moment, is a clear vulnerability that must be raised

Six months back, while talking about global growth you had said clouds of risk are on the horizon. Have your worst fears come true? I said successively "the sun is shining, fix the roof," that was a year ago. Six months back, I had said exactly that. "Watch out, clouds are on the horizon, it's time to fix the roof." We are now watching some of those clouds opening up a bit and it's not pouring yet but it is certainly begun to drizzle.

You have urged world leaders to fix global trade. In what way? Trade, when it works, is a win-win game and it's also a game which has to include everybody. It's a topic that we should have paid more attention to and we should now, in relation to trade and tech. I hope there will be de-escalation because players will appreciate the virtue and said into the table for fix global trade and not destroy it. That is my key message - de-escalate, fix, do not break.

Is there a new multilateralism that the world needs to come to terms with? Yes, it is an order where growth has to be more inclusive, growth has to be sustainable and there has to be more cooperation. Inclusive growth is important because if you have a system where, by virtue of trade, technology or policies, capital is favoured over labour, people will feel excluded, disenfranchised and no longer masters of their destiny. So we can't produce a cohesive, harmonious society. Sustainable growth is important because we have just one planet, we

The IMF has lauded India's structural reforms like the goods and services tax (GST) and the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, but has also said land and labour reforms are needed to move to a high-growth trajectory. How hopeful are you of these reforms, given we are less than a year away from elections and these are politically tough measures to take? The government, particularly finance minister Arun Jaitley, has been very determined, decisive and courageous in rolling out GST. I hope the benefits will be shown soon, especially how it simplifies tax laws. Bankruptcy reform was critical too. I would hope, whether it's now or in the short term, there will be a will to bring in crucial reforms like land and labour. I share your concern - the pre-election period isn't a great time to touch upon sensitive reforms.

What made you choose Gita Gopinath as IMF chief economist? She is a terribly talented economist. She is such an impressive human being. She happens to be a woman and I am very proud that finally IMF has a chief economist who is a woman... She is unbelievably talented. She has multiple interests, resources and an intellect that will take not just the research department of IMF but the institution itself in a direction that will better serve the membership. She is highly motivated to join us and we are thrilled that she is coming on January 3.

Do recently imposed import restrictions risk India being seen as protectionist? Does that concern you? Anything that raises protectionism or erects barriers to trade worries me. Trade has been extremely beneficial, lifted people out of poverty, reduced cost of living for many people. It has boosted productivity and improved innovation. We need to hang on to those benefits and not begin raising barriers and tariffs.

The #MeToo campaign has exploded in India. What do organisations need to do to tackle sexual harassment at work more decisively? You have to start with eliminating discrimination and promoting women. The more women there are at the top and at all managerial levels of an institution, the less horror stories there will be. I would also say that having legal provisions available to fight harassment is important and will help. India has a legal system in place and respects the rule of law. There needs to be greater adherence to anti-harassment provisions.
