

Pak's Krishna Kinnari featured on BBC's 100 women 2018

A HINDU WOMAN lawmaker and human rights activist in Pakistan has made it to the list of BBC's 100 Inspiring and Influential women from around the world.

Krishna Kumar Kohli, 40, Pakistan's first female senator from the Dair community, has been placed at No 48 on the annual BBC 100 Women list and recognised as a Pakistani politician. Krishna was elected as senator in March after spending many years working for the rights of bonded labourers in Pakistan. She is the first Thari Hindu woman to be elected to the Pakistan senate. Krishna was elected to the Pakistan Senate after campaigning for women's rights, having previously been forced into bonded labour for three years. BBC wrote about her.

The list includes woman like Chelsea Clinton, daughter of former US President Bill Clinton for her work with the

Clinton Foundation to Syrian student Mujeen Mustafa who fled the Syrian war in her wheelchair and campaigns for refugees with disabilities.

Krishna belongs to the Kohli community from the remote village of Dharia Gami in Nagarpur district of Sindh province where a sizeable number of Hindus live.

She was elected as Senator or member of Upper House of Parliament in March this year.

Iranian jobs go as US sanctions start to bite

THE IRANIAN RIAL has fallen to record lows and economic activity has slowed dramatically since US President Donald Trump withdrew from the big powers' nuclear deal with Tehran in May. He imposed sanctions directed at purchases of US dollars, gold trading, and the automotive industry in August. Iran's vital oil and banking sectors were hit in November.

"We have lost around five billion dollars (\$120,000 at the official rate) in the last few months, so the board decided to suspend all activities for as long as the fluctuations in the currency market continue. It is stupid to keep doing what you see fit as a dead end," Rashidi said. The country has already experienced unrest this year, when young protesters agitated by unemployment and high prices clashed with security forces. Official projections state sanctions could flare up again as markets make the economic crisis worse. —REUTERS
