There is an air of excitement at Anna University after Kurukshetra-2018 was inaugurated on Wednesday.

Tamilnadu Governor Banwarilal Purohit inaugurated 12th edition of Kurukshetra, the four-day international Techno Management Fest which has 35 competitive events.

Minister of Higher Education, K P Anbalagan, Dean of College of Engineering, T V Geetha, Principal Secretary to Government Higher Education Department, Sunil Palival, Commissioner of Directorate of Technical Education (DoTE), R Palanisamy, Registrar of Anna University, S Ganeshan, were present. Today, the students will be attending workshops on Software Designed Radio (SDR) and 5G network with guest speakers from Tenet Technologies and a guest lecture by Prof Baghyaveni, a veteran in SDR and networking field for 22

years. Another highlight of the day is a session on Samsung S-pay with four experts from the tech giant addressing students, and a session on Arduino Sat where technologists from Hydriotic Innovations will be speaking.

The students have a fun and interactive session with international memory athlete, Daniel Kilov, who displayed an array of visualised memory tricks on Wednesday.

The tradition of collecting E-waste for recycling and donating its proceeds for the cause of education will be done this time too.

What is Kurukshetra?

It is the international technomanagement fest of College of Engineering (CEG), Anna University. CEG is India's oldest engineering college.



at INS Parundu Naval Air Station located near Uchipili in Ramanathapuram district and visited INS Kattabomman in Tirunelveli district accompanied by Vice Admiral Karambir Singh where she was briefed about

the activities of the unit by Captain Vishal Gupta, the commanding officer. During the walk around the station Nirmala Sitharaman interacted with officers and sailors.

Naval Air Station in Rammad was established as a forward operating base and was commissioned as INS Parundu on 26 March 2009, according to a press release from the Defence Ministry.

It operated helicopters and remotely piloted aircraft for surveillance along south coast of Tamilnadu.

INS Kattabomman was commissioned on 20 October 1990 and it forms a vital link in communication chain of the Indian Navy and also provides logistic and administrative support for ships and submarines visiting Tuticorin Port.



3. The Company operates in a single segment i.e. Dealing with Chlor Alkali and Related Products/Services and hence, does not have any additional disclosures to be made under INDAS 106-Operating Segments.

The National Green Tribunal, in an application filed by a NGO, had granted an ex parte stay, restraining the construction activities pertaining to the expansion and operation of the Company's Plant without valid consent order. The Company strongly objected the avarments of the complainant and filed its counter for vacating the stay which was granted however the matter is pending with the Honourable forum for final disposal. Also Refer Note 6 below.
5. The name of the Company has been changed to Chemfab Alkalies Limited, vide the revised certificate of incorporation issued by the Registrar of Companies (ROC) dated 21 July 2017 pursuant to the Scheme of Amalgamation approved by the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) on 30 March 2017.
6. The Puducherry Pollution Control Committee has granted in-principle clearance for the enhancement of the production capacity of Caustic Soda from 125 TPD to 200 TPD vide order dated 28 November 2017 subject to other approval conditions and outcome of the National Green Tribunal Case. Subsequent to the receipt of in-principle approval, the Company has withdrawn its appeals filed against the denial of expansion. (Refer Note 4 above).
7. During the nine months ended 31 December 2017, the Company has redeemed 3,00,000 12% Redemovable Cumulative Preference Shares of Rs. 100 each aggregating to Rs. 300 lakhs and 2,60,000 11% Redemovable Cumulative Preference Shares of Rs. 100 each amounting to Rs. 260 lakhs in accordance with the applicable terms of redemption.

Twist to Amala Paul's sexual harassment case

Chennai, Feb 1: Azhagesan, who was arrested following a sexual harassment complaint from actress Amala Paul, has narrated a different tale to the police, contradicting her claim. Police said that Azhagesan, a resident of Kanathur on East Coast Road, was working as a manager in a garment factory. He had told the police during interrogation that he was sent to the actor by Ibrahim, a Malaysia-based businessman, to confirm her appointment for a private party.

An investigation officer, quoting Azhagesan, said Amala Paul's manager asked him to meet her at the studio. However, the manager has denied having a word with him. 'We are trying to confirm Azhagesan's claims with the help of his mobile records. But, it is getting delayed, as his mobile phone broke into pieces in the tussle with Amala Paul's guards,' police said.

On Wednesday, Amala Paul complained with Mambalam Police station stating that the man approached her for sexual favour during a dance practice for a show in Malaysia. The incident reportedly took place at Kollywood choreographer Sridhar's dance studio in the city. Amala also suspected that the man had inside contacts, which also propelled her to file a complaint. She said, 'He knew I was there at that time. That's why I thought it was unsafe because I am an independent working woman. So there is definitely a close source. That's how I knew I was there at the time. I feel extremely unsafe. Someone involved at the event has given him the information.'
