The reserves (excluding revaluation reserve, if any), as per the balance sheet of the previous accounting year not being mandatory, have not been presented.

- 5 The Company had applied for a scheme of amalgamation of 9 wholly owned subsidiary companies with the Holding Company. The appointed date of amalgamation is April 01, 2016. The application was filed with the Hon'ble National Company Law tribunal ("NCLT") on February 23, 2017. The Hon'ble NCLT has passed an order dated September 25, 2017 instructing the Company to conduct Secured Creditors Meeting and shareholders meeting in November 2017. Introduction

Explanatory notes to the condensed interim unaudited unconsolidated special purpose financial information for nine months ended December 31, 2017

1. Corporate information

a. Gokaldas Exports Limited ('the Company') was incorporated on March 1, 2004 by converting the erstwhile partnership firm Gokaldas India under Part IX of the Companies Act,1956 ('the Act'). Pursuant to the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka dated November 20, 2004, Gokaldas Exports Private Limited and The Unique Creations (Bangalore) Private Limited had been amalgamated with the Company, with April 1, 2004 being the appointed date. The Company currently operates a 100% Export Oriented Unit, a Domestic Tariff Area Unit and a Special Economic Zone Unit.

The Company is a public company domiciled in India and its shares are listed on two stock exchanges in India. The Company is engaged in the business of design, manufacture, and sale of a wide range of garments for men, women, and children and caters to the needs of several leading international fashion brands and retailers. The principal source of revenue for the Company is from export of garments and related products.

b. These Condensed Interim Unaudited Unconsolidated Financial Information have been prepared by the management for the purpose of its inclusion in the Placement Documents in connection with the proposed issue of equity shares of face value of ₹ 5 each through a qualified institutions placement prepared by the Company.

2. Basis of preparation of financial information and significant accounting policies

i. Basis of preparation of financial information

In accordance with the notification issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, the Company the Company has adopted Indian Accounting Standards ('referred as Ind AS') prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 and the Companies (Accounting Standards) Amendment Rules, 2016 with effect from April 1, 2016. Accordingly, the Company's management has prepared the Condensed Interim Unaudited Unconsolidated Special Purpose Financial Information which comprise the Balance Sheets as at December 31, 2017, March 31, 2016 and the Opening Balance Sheet as at April 1, 2015 (transition date balance sheet), the Statements of Profit and Loss, the Statements of Cash Flows and the Statements of Changes in Equity for the nine-month period ended December 31, 2017 and for nine-month period ended December 31, 2016, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information (together hereinafter referred to as "Condensed Interim Unaudited Unconsolidated Special Purpose Financial Information") in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles of Ind AS to the extent applicable and is not a complete set of Ind AS compliant financial statements and accordingly, all the disclosures as required under Ind AS have not been furnished in these Condensed Interim Unaudited Unconsolidated Special Purpose Financial Information. The interim financial information has been prepared under the historical cost basis, except for certain financial assets and liabilities which has been measured at fair value.

These financial statements are prepared for inclusion in the Placement Documents prepared in connection with its proposed issue of equity shares of face value of ₹ 5 each through a qualified institutions placement by the Company. The Company will prepare and issue its first complete Ind AS unconsolidated financial statements as at and for the year ending March 31, 2018. Until the first complete Ind AS consolidated financial statements are issued, the balances in the Condensed Interim Unaudited Unconsolidated Special Purpose Financial Information can change if (a) there are any new Ind AS standards issued (b) there are any amendments/modifications made to existing Ind AS standards or interpretations thereof effecting the Ind AS balances in these Condensed Interim Unaudited Unconsolidated Special Purpose Financial Information and (c) if the Company makes any changes in the elections and/or exemptions selected on adoption of Ind AS at its transition date of April 1, 2016. Only a complete set of consolidated financial statements together with comparative financial information can provide a fair presentation of the state of affairs (financial position) of the Company, profit or loss (financial performance including other comprehensive income), cash flows and the changes in equity.

ii. Significant accounting policies

a. Functional and presentation currency

The functional and presentation currency of the Company is Indian Rupee (Rs.) which is the currency of the primary economic environment in which the Company operates. All amounts have been rounded-off to the nearest lakhs, unless otherwise indicated.





b. Use of estimates and judgements

The preparation of the Company's Condensed Interim Unaudited Unconsolidated Special Purpose Financial Information requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amount of revenues, expenses, assets and liabilities, and the accompanying disclosures, and the disclosure of contingent liabilities. Actual results could differ from those estimates. Estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Uncertainty about these assumptions and estimates could result in outcomes that require a material adjustment to the carrying amount of assets or liabilities affected in future periods.

The estimates and the underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimate is revised and future periods affected.

Significant judgements and estimates relating to the carrying values of assets and liabilities include impairment of investments in subsidiaries and associates, provision for employee benefits and other provisions, recoverability of deferred tax assets, commitments and contingencies etc.

2.1 Summary of significant accounting policies

a. Current versus non-current classification

The Company presents assets and liabilities in the balance sheet based on current/ non-current classification. An asset is treated as current when it is:

- Expected to be realized or intended to be sold or consumed in normal operating cycle
- Held primarily for the purpose of trading
- Expected to be realized within twelve months after the reporting period, or
- Cash or cash equivalent unless restricted from being exchanged or used to settle a liability for at least twelve months
 after the reporting period

All other assets are classified as non-current.

A liability is current when:

- It is expected to be settled in normal operating cycle
- It is held primarily for the purpose of trading
- It is due to be settled within twelve months after the reporting period, or
- There is no unconditional right to defer the settlement of the liability for at least twelve months after the reporting period

The Company classifies all other liabilities as non-current.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are classified as non-current assets and liabilities.

Advance tax paid is classified as non-current assets.

The operating cycle is the time between the acquisition of assets for processing and their realisation in cash and cash equivalents.
