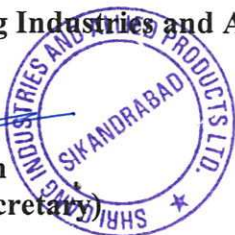

MESSI SHOW LIGHTS UP WC WARM-UP

'La Pulga' strikes thrice as Argentina beat Haiti 4-0 in pre-World Cup friendly; Peru win & Panama play draw

PTI ■ BUENOS AIRES

Lionel Messi warmed up for next month's FIFA World Cup with a hat-trick as he inspired Argentina to a morale-boosting win over Haiti in a pre-tournament friendly here.

Messi scored a quickfire second-half double (58th and 68th minutes) to add to a first-half (17th minute) penalty, before setting up substitute Sergio Aguero (69th) as Jorge Sampaoli's side hammered the Caribbean minnows in their final phase of preparations for the showpiece event.

With this hat-trick, the FC Barcelona talisman took his international tally to 64 goals in 124 appearances.

The Albiceleste, who are two-time world champions, had struggled throughout the qualifying campaign but the thoroughly dominating display here should boost their confidence even though the win came against a side that has not qualified for the World Cup.

Haiti could not even register a shot at the goal in the whole match.

It was a night of celebration for another Barcelona star as Javier Mascherano joined Javier Zanetti as Argentina's most capped player with 143 international appearances.

"I have no doubt that we are going to grow, we have time, this team is going to take shape."

"We have been working hard on the physical, I think we have a nice opportunity to try again, we are going to be very excited, as always," Messi said after the match.

Argentina play Iceland in Moscow in their first match of the World Cup on June 16.

Sampaoli was upbeat about his superstar No 10, saying, "Messi is training very well, he finished the Spanish tournament and two days later he was here, he looks very enthusiastic."

Against Iceland we will have to take advantage of the minute we have a high level of force in the World Cup."

PERU CRUISE OVER SCOTLAND

Peru defeated Scotland 2-0 in an international friendly ahead of the 2018 FIFA World Cup, stretching their unbeaten streak to 13 games.

In the Estadio Nacional here crammed with about 45,000 football fans on Tuesday night, Peru demonstrated rhythm and strength against a disciplined but inferior Scotland, with goals from Christian Cueva and Jefferson Farfan, reports EFE news agency.

The team coached by Ricardo Gareca was formidable enough despite the absence of captain and striker, Paolo Guerrero, and was armed with good offensive strategy.

The Peruvians had their first chance to score a goal at 5 minutes, with a free kick by Cueva that was sent to the corner by Scottish goalkeeper Jordan Archer.

From that moment on, it was 20 minutes of absolute dominance by the home team who waited for the right moment to break through the rigid defensive scheme of the Scots.

By the 25th minute, the Peruvians retreated a few meters and chose to make some long passes to Farfan, which, however, did not result in much except for a weak shot from the forward that reached the hands of Archer.

When Scotland had loosened up a bit and made some timid offensive attempts, Peru responded in depth with Farfan and Sergio Arce, but his goal-shot was blocked with an arm by Scott McKenna leading to a penalty.

Cueva finally scored a penalty shot at 37 minutes thereby opening the scoreboard in favour of the Peruvians and amid the excitement of fans.

In the beginning of the second half, Farfan received two passes from Yoshimar Yotun and scored Peru's second goal at 47 minutes despite Archer's effort to block it.

Peru will depart Wednesday for Europe where they will end their training and play the friendly against Saudi Arabia and Sweden, before arriving in Russia, marking its historic return to the World Cup after 36 years.

PANAMA HELD BY NORTHERN IRELAND

Amid massive support from the public, mostly dressed in red, the Panamanian national football team played out a 0-0 stalemate against Northern Ireland in an international friendly here.

In a festive atmosphere at the Rommel Fernandez Stadium here on Tuesday night, the home team played well, giving a glimpse of what can be expected from the Central Americans at the 2018 Russia World Cup, reports EFE news agency.

Seventeen minutes into the game, as the Panamanians sought the elusive goal Edgar Joel Barcenas did a header which hit the crossbar and failed to translate into a score.

A lost ball from the Panamanian midfielder put the team at risk when at 29 minutes came a header from Northern Ireland's Josh Magennis, but which landed in the hands of Panamanian goalkeeper Jose Calderon.

Between the 34th and 40th minutes the game fell into a rut with strong legwork in the midfield.



Ghana spoil Nishino's Japan debut

Akira Nishino made his debut as Japan coach on Wednesday in a 2-0 loss to Ghana.

In steady rain at Nissan Stadium, Thomas Partey gave Ghana a 1-0 lead in the ninth minute with free kick from the top of the area.

Emmanuel Boateng doubled the advantage for the penalty spot in the 51st.

Nishino, who will name his World Cup squad on Thursday, brought substitute Shinji Kagawa and Shinji Okazi in the second half when Japan created more chances but was unable to beat Ghana goalkeeper Richard Ofori.

"We had chances but couldn't capitalize so it's a disappointing result," Nishino said. "I'm still considering many factors before tomorrow's announcement."

After only two weeks working with his players, Nishino opted for experience with defenders Tomoaki Makino, Makoto Hasebe and Maya Yoshida in front of goalkeeper Eiji Kawashima.

Also in the starting 11 was veteran Keisuke Honda, who played at right forward alongside Takashi Usami and Yuya Osako. Honda never scored midway through the first half but his angled shot from close range was denied by Ofori.

Japan fired Vahid Halilhodzic last month, only two months before the World Cup opens, and replaced him with Nishino.

'Brazil ready to atone for 2014 World Cup pain'

Thiago Silva has vowed that Brazil will be physically and mentally prepared when the FIFA World Cup starts in Russia on June 14.

The Paris Saint-Germain (PSG) defender said a desire to atone for the team's humiliating 7-1 semi-final defeat at home to Germany in the 2014 World Cup serves as an extra incentive, reports Xinhua news agency.

"I think (Cote) and his backroom staff have prepared the squad well," Silva told a press conference in London, where he is currently training ahead of football's flagship tournament.

"I think we are ready to perform well. If we look back at that (the 2014 loss to Germany), it only gives us more motivation to go to the World Cup and win it," he added.

Silva, who will be playing in his third World Cup, is not guaranteed of a starting berth in Russia.

The 33-year-old will be vying for a place in Tite's preferred line-up with his PSG teammate Marquinhos and Internazionale's Miranda.

"Both are great players. Miranda has shown that throughout his career and Marquinhos has started very well. The competition for places is healthy and lifts the level of concentration," he said.

Brazil's options in central defence also include Geromel, a key member of the Gremio side that won last year's Copa Libertadores, South America's top club competition.

The five-time world champions will begin their campaign in Russia against Switzerland on June 17 before facing Costa Rica and Serbia in Group E.

"We have a chance to play another World Cup and rewrite our story, Silva said.

"We cannot promise the title, but we can promise great matches. By the time the World Cup comes around you will see us playing great football."

CASEMIRO, MARCELO ARRIVE AT CAMP

LONDON. Real Madrid teammates Marcelo and Casemiro have arrived at Tottenham's training center to complete Brazil's 23-man World Cup squad.

The left back and midfielder missed the first week of training in Teresopolis, outside Rio de Janeiro, and the first two days of practice in London because they were helping Madrid win the Champions League.

With the late additions, Brazil coach Tite has his complete squad for the first time. Liverpool striker Roberto Firmino arrived Monday.

Brazil, who will face Croatia on Sunday at Anfield, will stay in London for training until June 8.

The team will then travel to Vienna to play their last pre-World Cup friendly against Austria.

'SALAH WILL BE AT WC, GOD WILLING'

Mohamed Salah could still play a role for Egypt at the World Cup after the Egyptian Football Association announced Wednesday that the injured Liverpool striker would be out for 'not more than three weeks.'

The football federation reiterates that Salah will be at the World Cup, God willing, and will be out for no longer than three weeks," the federation said after its president Hani Abu Reda and the team doctor met with Salah in Spain, where he is undergoing treatment.

Egypt's opening fixture in Group A is against Uruguay on June 15. They then face Russia on June 19 and Saudi Arabia on June 25.



Arabia on June 25. "Salah is a body blow for Egypt and their star striker. Liverpool's photo had stated that the player will face three to four weeks out with the shoulder injury suffered in the UEFA Champions League final."

"He (Salah) is sad about what happened but is totally focused on recovery, seeing when he can be ready," physio Ruben Pons told Marca.

"In principle it will be between three and four weeks, but we will try to reduce those dates — that's the big goal."

Salah was hacked down by Real Madrid defender Sergio Ramos in the first half of the Champions League final in Kiev.

Colombia train in Italy ahead of Egypt friendly

Coach Jose Pekerman put the Colombian national football team through the paces here ahead of this week's pre-World Cup friendly against Egypt in nearby Bergamo.

The clash with Egypt on Friday will give Pekerman the chance to try out different combinations as he decides who among the 35 players he brought to Italy will make the final 23-man roster, reports EFE news agency.

The preliminary squad includes 11 veterans of the Colombian side that reached the quarter-finals of the 2014 World Cup before falling to hosts Brazil.

Some of the stars of that campaign, such as midfielder James Rodriguez and goalkeeper David Ospina, will certainly be making the trip to Russia.

Though he missed the 2014 World Cup due to injury, Radamel Falcao, Colombia's all-time leading scorer with 29 goals in 71 appearances, is also vying to be in the squad.

For the 2018 tournament, Colombia will be part of Group H, along with Poland, Senegal, and Japan.

The Colombians will begin their quest for a berth in the knockout stage with a match against Japan on June 19.

'Sunil bhai and I complement each other'

India striker Jeje Lalpekhlua Tuesday said he and skipper Sunil Chhetri complement each other well upfront whenever they turn up for the national side.

The Mizor striker, who is enjoying a dream run of form goals in 71 appearances, on a regular basis at the domestic and international level, made special mention of his partnership with Chhetri during India's preparatory camp here ahead of the Hero Intercontinental Cup.

Lalpekhlua, who is three matches short of 50 international caps for India, added that everyone in the team is willing to share the burden and carry the responsibility.
