Par panel finalises report on Wage Code Bill: Gangwar

LABOUR MINISTER SANTOSH Gangwar on Tuesday said a parliamentary standing committee has finalised its report on first labour code, Wage Code Bill 2017, and the legislation would be pushed for passage in the monsoon session of Parliament after the document is submitted.

The law will enable the central government to set benchmark minimum wages for different regions across the country. The bill's provision provides that states cannot set minimum wages below the benchmark set

by the Centre. "I have spoken to the chairman of the committee regarding finalisation of its report on Wage Code Bill. He told me that everything is completed and it will be submitted soon. We will push (the bill) for passage," Gangwar told reporters on the sidelines of the International Labour Day.

The draft code on the bill was introduced in the Lok Sabha in August 2017. Thereafter, it was referred to the committee for

scrutiny which is expected to submit its report in the monsoon session.

The bill also seeks to combine Payment of Wages Act, 1936, the Minimum Wages Act, 1949, the Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, and the Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, into one code.

A senior official said that if everything goes well, the bill can be pushed for passage in the forthcoming monsoon session of Parliament.

'Shocked' SC slams govt for 'exploiting' poor

"THIS IS TOO much. This is exploitation of the poor," a "shocked" Supreme Court on Tuesday told the government when it said it has set up a committee to fix a timeline to comply with its directions on a matter relating to the welfare of construction workers.

"Is this the attitude of the Government of India towards poor people?" it asked the counsel appearing for the Centre while expressing anguish over the submission.

"For fixing a timeline, you have set up a committee? What is this going on? According to us, you are sitting on (rupees) 20,000 crore to 25,000 crore. Is this the attitude of the Government of India towards poor people of the country?" a bench, comprising Justices Madan B Lokur and Deepak Gupta, said.

"This is too much. This is exploitation of the poor," the bench said while asking the government what it has done with the huge amount of money meant for the welfare of construction workers. Incidentally, the strong observations of the top court came on the International Labour Day.

The top court also directed the secretary of ministry of labour to remain present before it on May 7 to explain what was happening regarding the implementation of its order and two laws enacted by Parliament on the matter.

When the counsel representing some parties told the bench that they have complied with the directions passed by the top court, the bench shot back, "what have you done except buying washing machines and laptops?"

"This is shocking. Is this a joke? These (construction workers) are people who have no education, no money and builders are exploiting them and the Government of India is saying that they will not do anything," an angry bench observed.

Earlier, an affidavit filed in the court by Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) had said that a chunk of funds meant for construction workers' welfare had been spent to buy laptops and washing machines and less than 10% was spent for the actual purpose.

The court had on March 19 asked the Centre to frame a model scheme before September 30 to address the issues of education, health, social security and pension for construction workers.

It had said that more than ₹37,400 crore had been collected for the benefit of these workers, but ostensibly only about ₹9,500 crore was utilised for their benefit.

It had also questioned why millions of construction workers across the country were being denied the benefit of remaining ₹28,000 crore.

The top court had also directed the state governments and union territories to constitute an expert committee and bring out statutory rules within six months.

It had said that its directions given from time to time for implementation of two laws have been "flouted with impunity".

Versace plans to launch furniture range in India

ITALIAN FURNITURE AND lifestyle major Gianni Versace is planning to bring in its range of furniture in India to tap the fast-growing luxury market here.

At present, furniture is the only product category in Versace's portfolio that is not available in India.

"We are looking (at launching the furniture range). We have no reason why we shouldn't," Gabriella Saracino, Worldwide Licensing and Home Division Director, Gianni Versace told PTI.

However, she did not share the timeline of the launch of the furniture

range in India. "We want to be 100% sure (before launching) that it is the right location and the right partner."

On being asked whether Versace would partner locals here for its furniture range, she said, "In distribution, yes. But the production would be in Italy".

Saracino further added, "We do not want any compromise on our quality. Our

furniture was made in Italy. If people want quality, they buy our products. Otherwise, there are several other options in the market".

Versace's furniture is made in Italy and exported to different markets. The home division, which includes furniture, accounts for 10% of Versace's total turnover.

Founded in 1978 in Milan, Gianni Versace is one of the leading international fashion design houses. It designs, manufactures, distributes and retails fashion

and lifestyle products, including haute couture, accessories, jewellery, watches, eyewear, and home furnishings.

Last week, Versace and realty firm Unity Group announced tie-up for developing

Delhi's tallest building, comprising 160 branded luxury apartments, with an investment of about ₹500 crore.

This was Versace's second real estate project here, the first was in Mumbai with ABIL group, Saracino added.

On being asked whether the group is looking at partners for luxury real estate projects, she said, "At the moment, we want to concentrate of this (project)."

Dabur Q4 profit jumps 19% to ₹397 crore

FMCG MAJOR DABUR India on Tuesday reported a 19.04% increase in consolidated net profit at ₹397.18 crore for the fourth quarter ended March 2018 on strong volume growth and rise in operating margin.

The company had posted a net profit of ₹333.65 crore in the January-March period a year ago, Dabur India said in a BSE filing.

Total income during the quarter under review grew 6.38% to ₹2,106.15 crore, against ₹1,979.72 crore in the corresponding quarter a year ago.

base in Old Mysuru, is looking to JD(S) to launch a serious offensive in Chamundeshwari, enough to give Siddaramaiah the jitters so that he is wary of moving out of the constituency. Simultaneously, the party has rolled out big gun Sreeramulu in Badami, who could leave Siddaramaiah uneasy here too. He cannot bank purely on the caste matrix for a walkover, with the OBCs, primarily Kurubas, comprising 42,000 of the 2.14 lakh electorate.

"Fielding Sreeramulu in Badami is only to lock Siddaramaiah in the constituency. We're not looking at a victory for him, but to ensure the CM does not take Badami lightly and is forced to run a campaign personally in north Karnataka," said a BJP party worker. As a result, Siddaramaiah may neither be able to protect Chamundeshwari nor help son Yathindra in Varuna, towards the last leg of campaigning.

Rallying cry: Cash up front, or no go

The who's who has descended on Karnataka to campaign amid soaring temperatures. Every major leader is expecting large crowds. In Uttara Kannada, the scorching heat has made getting crowds a difficult proposition. Usually, the promise of money works, but people have become much savvier. During a leader's recent visit to Ankola, people were ferried in buses and other vehicles. But the voters said they would get into the vehicles only if they were paid money in advance. Current rates are reported to be anywhere between Rs 300 and Rs 500 per rally, and free meals.

Siddaramaiah won from Varuna in 2013, and his younger son has been fielded this time. This is Yathindra's poll debut — the pathological quip his practice to join politics after the untimely death of elder brother and Siddaramaiah's political heir, Rakesh, in 2016.

JD(S), meanwhile, has ensured in its own way that there is no respite for Siddaramaiah in either constituency by pitting strong contenders against the Congress chief minister.


While in Badami, JD(S) candidate Hanamant Ma-

New Delhi: Concerned over the Taj Mahal turning brown and green in colour due to rising pollution levels, the Supreme Court on Tuesday asked the Centre and UP government to rope in international experts to preserve the marble monument, lamenting that the authorities had failed to protect it.

A bench of Justices Madan B Lokur and Deepak Gupta expressed shock after perusing the latest pictures of Taj Mahal, showing its pristine white marble changing colour due to pollution, and directed the authorities to consult renowned experts from the country and abroad to preserve the historical monument.

"Earlier it was turning yellow and now it is becoming brown and green. It is very serious. It seems you are helpless. It has to be saved. You can get help from experts from outside to assess the damage done and restore it," the bench said.

Additional Solicitor General (ASG) ANS Nadkarni, appearing for the Centre, told the bench that it was the duty of ASI to preserve and protect the monument. He said there were many experts in the country whose help could be sought for preserving the heritage.

"There seems to be lack of will and expertise," the bench said and asked for a plan to re-

As a controversy rages over the government's decision to allow Dalmia Bharat Group to "adopt" the iconic Red Fort for maintenance under its 'Adopt a Heritage' project, chairman of parliamentary standing committee on tourism and TMC MP Derek O'Brien refuted reports that the panel gave its nod to the proposal for adoption of monuments by corporate houses.

Advocate M C Mehta, who had been fighting a legal battle for the last three decades for preserving the monument, said the Centre and state government had not followed the Supreme Court's various orders, resulting in damage to the heritage site. He suggested that contempt proceedings be initiated against them for not complying with the apex court's order in true spirit.

BY Vijayendra, younger son of BJP's CM-face B S Yeddyurappa, is a disappointed man. Denied a poll ticket, Vijayendra says the disappointment is for his workers and "defectors" from other parties who joined BJP due to an assurance that Yeddyurappa's son will contest from Varuna. Excerpts:

The battle for Varuna within your party ended with you losing the ticket at the last moment. What happened?

I will not deny that I am disappointed. But my disappointment is not over not getting a ticket but for my party workers, who worked for me, and local gram panchayat leaders who defected from JD(S) and Congress to BJP, purely because of my possible candidature.

Now, I suspect it will take at least three to four days for me to calm tears and emotions in Varuna. With our

candidate a relatively new face, we will have to start afresh.

How do you assess the ground situation?

BJP could have easily won a minimum of 10 to 15 seats in Old Mysuru region but after this development, we are yet to assess the situation. But we are confident of securing at least 7 to 8 seats, considering our party base in the region is minimal.

Lingayats are concerned that if you were denied the ticket by the central leadership, the same treatment would be meted out to your father for the CM's post, if BJP wins

Ours is a national party and there have been repeated assurances from both PM Modi and party chief Amit Shah that Yeddyurappa will become CM and remain so for five years. The party denying me a ticket has nothing

to do with my father becoming CM. The relationship between my father and PM Modi is over and above our local rapport within the party.

So was it the dynastic politics rhetoric — which BJP has been campaigning on — that was behind your losing the ticket?

Neither me nor my brother B Y Raghavendra wanted to enter politics. My brother was fielded from Shivamogga due to the circumstances when former CM S Bangarappa contested from that seat. We needed someone formidable so my brother took on Bangarappa. I had never dreamed of entering politics. The central leadership personally sought my candidature from Varuna and neither my father nor I was inclined to bring in another Yeddyurappa family member into politics.
