The figures of the last quarters are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year upto March 31, 2018 and March 31, 2017 and the unaudited published year-to-date figures upto December 31, 2017 and the December 31, 2016, being the date of the end of the third quarter of the financial year which were subjected to limited review.

5. The Board of Directors have recommended, subject to approval of shareholders, dividend of Rs. 10 per share (post share split Rs. 2 per share of face value of Rs. 2 each) (March 31, 2017: Rs. 4.70 per share) of Rs. 10 each for the year ended March 31, 2018.

6. Post applicability of Goods and Services Tax (GST) w.e.f. July 01, 2017, Revenue from Operations are required to be disclosed net of GST in accordance with the requirement of Ind AS. Accordingly, the Revenue from Operations for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2018 are not comparable with the immediately preceding quarter ended / year ended March 31, 2017 and corresponding previous periods presented in the financial results which are reported inclusive of Excise Duty.
