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INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF BHEEMA CEMENTS LIMITED

 We have audited the accompanying Statement of Standalone Financial Results of BHEEMA CEMENTS LIMITED ("the Company"), for the year ended March 31, 2017 ("the Statement") included in the accompanying Statement of Audited Standalone Financial Results, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016.

This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been compiled from the related standalone financial statements which has been prepared in accordance with the Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued there-under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Statement based on our audit of such standalone financial statements.

 We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Statement is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and the disclosures in the Statement. The procedures selecte depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the Statement, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the audit or considers internal control relevant to the Company's preparation and fair presentation of the Statement in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Company's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of the accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by the Management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the Statement. We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

- In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the Statement:
- (i) is presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/ FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016; and

- v. The Company has not provided for liability on Gratuity and leave encashment, the impact of which is not ascertainable in the absence of adequate information.
- vi. The Company has provided for salaries expenditure at less than the contracted rates which is based on management perception wholly and not based on any agreement with the concerned parties and hence the salaries are understated by Rs.43.23 Lakhsfor the quarter and the liabilities are understated by an equal amount.
- vii. The company has not provided for the deferred tax liability for the current financial year and had reversed provision for the earlier years during the previous financial year. In the absence of adequate information we are unable to quantify the effect of such non provision for the current year, but the accumulated losses have been understated till the previous financial year by an amount of Rs.395.09 Lakhs and the liabilities have been understated by that amount due to reversal of provision for earlier years during the previous financial years.
- viii. The liabilities towards power bills amounting to Rs.381.55 Lakhs for the period April 2014 to September 2014 had been reversed during the previous financial year based on the representation made to the South Power Distribution Company Of Telangana Ltd (DISCOM). We are of the opinion that the reversal of the provision should have been done based only on a communication from the DISCOM about the withdrawal of such charges. The impact of the reversal of power charges of the previous year is that the loss the current year is Nil (previous year lower by Rs. 381.55 Lacs) and the liabilities are understated by an equal amount.
- ix. The balances of the Sundry Debtors, Sundry Creditors, Loans including the Deposits and Advances are subject to confirmation from and reconciliation with the relevant parties as on the balance sheet date. We are not in a position to certify the amounts at which such balances are actually receivables and payable.
- x. The company has disposed of used assets which are under charge during the year. This may have impact on the contractual obligations of the company with the banks and other secured lenders.
- 4. The Statement includes the results for the Quarter ended March 31, 2017 being the balancing figure between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year which were subject to limited review by us.
