## Cancerous shoes row: Distribution done only after quality check, says Shejwar

Amid ongoing political slugfest over presence of cancerous 'AZODIE' in shoes and slippers distributed to more than 10 lakh tribals, forest minister Gaurishankar Shejwar on Saturday said shoes were distributed only after assessing their quality. There is no danger of cancer from them, he declared.

Accepting that cancerous 'AZODIE' was detected in around two lakh pairs of shoes during

quality check, he said that the lot was rejected well before the distribution.

Meanwhile, Jay Adiwasi Yuva Sangathan (JAYS) chief Dr Hira Lal Alawa demanded that shoes and slippers distributed among tribals be recalled and deposited at collectorate. He further said that new pair of shoes be distributed accordingly.

Joining issue with Shejwar, state Congress president Kamal Nath demanded that the shoes and slippers be withdrawn and replaced with branded ones. He also demanded a high-level probe into the matter. Nath also asked the government to clarify its stand on the issue.

## In run up to polls, netas use defamation suit to silence rivals

Politicians in poll-bound Madhya Pradesh have turned defamation case into a political tool to settle scores with their opponents. Many of the defamation suits filed by Congress and BJP ahead of 2013 elections are still lingering on in different courts of the state. As the assembly elections are drawing near, these lingering cases are being pushed to create sensation and achieve political mileage. Defamation suit comes in handy to silence their rivals and score some brownie points by playing victim card. Recently, former CM and Congress leader Digvijaya Singh threatened to file a defamation case against Chief Minister Shrivraj Singh Chouhan for dubbing him "anti-national". In the past, CM Chouhan vs KK Mishra and ex-CM Digvijaya Singh vs Uma Bharati defamation cases had created a massive buzz in the political circle. Similarly, Ujjain

MLA Kalpana Perulekar was convicted on April 10, 2017 in a defamation case filed by Vidhan Sabha principal secretary Bhagwandev Ishrani. Perulekar had leveled serious allegations against Ishrani in a press conference on November 23, 2012.

### Chouhan vs Mishra

CM Shrivraj Singh Chouhan had filed defamation against Congress leader KK Mishra. Even Mishra was convicted by the lower court on November 17, 2017. However, the Supreme Court overruled the verdict and dismissed the case stating that a defamation case should be filed in individual capacity and not in the capacity of the CM. This year Chouhan filed a defamation case in individual capacity. Mishra during a press conference in June 2014 had claimed that 19 people from Gondia, the hometown of CM's wife, were illegally recruited as constables in the state transport department. Mishra had alleged the state transport constable recruitment test was a part of the Vyapam scam - a massive admission and recruitment racket in state.

## Lets win election and then choose leader: Ajay

### 'Vyapam scam, nutritious food and e-tender scams will be probed afresh'

The Congress will form government in the state if selection of candidates is done properly, said Leader of Opposition (LoP) Ajay Singh while talking to Free Press on Saturday. Excerpts

FP: Congress has lost three elections in a row. What do you see this time?

Singh: Reasons were different each time the Congress lost an election. In 2003, it was anti-incumbency factor. In 2008, few other reasons led to party's defeat in a tight contest. We became weak in 2013 as BJP emerged stronger across the country. This time, the state government is in a position similar to our government in 2003.

FP: What is important for the Congress?

Singh: Proper candidate selection is the key. If party workers start cashing in on public resentment against the BJP, no one can stop Congress from coming to power.

FP: Factionalism in the Congress is an obstacle in forming the government. Is it still prevalent?

Singh: Even if senior leaders indulge in it, workers will not let anything go wrong this time. Party workers at the grass-root level are worked up and

ready to form the government. It is visible.

FP: Deepak Babaria said that either Jyotiraditya Scindia or Kamal Nath will become chief minister. What do you think?

Singh: Congress leaders have decided that CM face of the party will not be projected before the elections. I believe that the leader should be selected only after the party wins the elections. The party high command and leaders of the legislature party should elect the leader. No one should talk about who will be the leader during campaigning.

FP: Where do you see yourself in race for chief minister?

Singh: I am not in race. Our priority is to form the Congress government in the state.

FP: Why is it that Congress levels allegations during elections and remains inactive otherwise?

Singh: It is true that Congress failed to grill the BJP government on corruption. It also shows that the government is quite clever in covering up the scams. Those in the government have become shameless. The issue of Vyapam was raised across the country. Neither anyone showed moral standing on the matter, nor was any action taken against the guilty.

FP: What will the Congress do if it comes to power?

Singh: The Congress government will order a fresh probe into Vyapam, e-tender and nutritious food scams. It is certain that

files of all big scams during the BJP rule in the state will be opened.

FP: Who is responsible for corruption, the government or the bureaucrats?

Singh: Almost all bureaucrats in the state are good. Officers who are honest and have clean image are being sidelined. Some bureaucrats with suspicious credentials are indulging in wrong deeds. Good people are unable to speak out their mind because of fear.

FP: What issues will you take to the public?

Singh: The farmers and the poor are in trouble. Ir-

regularities abound. Petty leaders of the BJP are influencing all work in districts. Every area has its own issues. I have asked party leaders to focus on local issues. Vindhya, Malwa and Mahakausal have their own set of problems which should be identified and raised.

FP: In which region is good for Congress poll prospects?

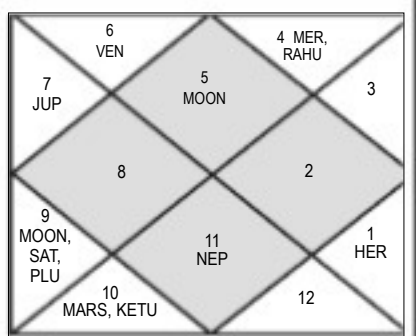
Singh: BNP governments

The CM and ministers in the current government believe in escaping from the House. The BJP has no faith in democracy. Media is also being suppressed.
