Aircel-Maxis case: ED questions Chidambaram

THE ENFORCEMENT Directorate (ED) on Friday questioned former finance minister P Chidambaram for the third time in the Aircel-Maxis case. Sources said Chidambaram, who arrived at the ED office before noon, was questioned for five hours. He was questioned on various aspects of the Foreign Investment Promotion Board (FIPB) approval given for the Aircel-Maxis deal, sources said.

They said he was also confronted with answers given by members of FIPB questioned by the ED earlier. These answers, sources said, were divergent from those given by Chidambaram during his questioning earlier.

Chidambaram, along with his son Karti, is being probed by the CBI and the ED for allegedly allowing foreign direct investment into the Aircel-Maxis deal in contravention of rules for alleged pecuniary gains. He has denied the allegations on multiple occasions and said the ED is probing him without registering an FIR in the case.

Chidambaram, after a similar questioning by the ED in this case in June, had said that what he told the agency was already recorded in government documents. "More than half the time taken up by typing the answers without errors, reading the statement and signing it," he had said in his tweet.

HE HAD OPPOSED VAJPAYEE TRIBUTE

Jailed AIMIM corporator posed threat to public order, say police

TWO DAYS after he was sent to jail for one year, the Aurangabad Police has defended the invoking of the stringent Maharashtra Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Slumlords, Bootleggers and Drug Offenders Act (MPDA) against All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) corporator Sayyed Mateen saying he had nine cases against him and that he was a "danger to public order".

The MPDA was invoked against Mateen days after he opposed a resolution to pay tribute to former prime minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee at an Aurangabad Municipal Corporation meeting on August 17.

Then, he was also assaulted allegedly by BJP corporators and was rushed out of the meeting by police.

After the incident, two separate offences were registered against Mateen including one under Section 153A of the IPC (promoting enmity between different groups). A separate case of vandalism was registered later.

Mateen was arrested on August 18 and was kept in custody till August 21, while five BJP corporators were arrested

and later released on bail. Minutes after Mateen was granted bail on August 21, he was held again, this time under the MPDA.

His family has said that he is a victim of a "political conspiracy" and that they would approach the courts. AIMIM MLA from Aurangabad, Imtiaz Jaleel, said, "We have already clarified that what he said in the corporation meeting on August 17 is not the party's stand. It was his own action. Having said this, we condemn the brutality against him and also invoking the stringent act. This is police excess. We will not only challenge the bail granted to the BJP corporators but also be looking at legal remedies against the

preventive detention."

Aurangabad police commissioner Chiranjeev Prasad said that action against Mateen under the MPDA was not a consequence of the August 17 incident.

"There was already a proposal for his externment under process. He has a total of nine offences against him which include attempt to murder, causing communal disharmony, attacking a public servant, arson and vandalism. These offences are from 2014," he said.

"Considering his actions and increased involvement in crime, a proposal for his externment from Aurangabad was under consideration. When two more offences were regis-

tered against him on August 17, a decision was taken to take action against him under the MPDA considering his criminal activities and danger to public order."

Police said that the nine cases against Mateen included attempt to murder, which was registered against Mateen during the communal riots in May in Aurangabad. Other offences include vandalism and attacking a public servant were registered against him around the time he became a corporator in 2015.

A purported video of the incident on August 17 shows Mateen was beaten up with footwear and even kicked by some corporators present on the floor. The video also shows police rushing Rashid out of the hall.

Irshad Fatema, Mateen's mother, said: "They showed that video repeatedly on TV. Someone even counted how many times he was beaten. And now he being sent to jail for one year. What will happen to his wife and children? This is a conspiracy against my son by some people who did not want him to succeed in politics. He was not even released for Eid."

According to his father Sayyed Rashid, they plan to approach the courts. "We have been told that we can apply for bail. We are in touch with AIMIM leaders and we will approach the court after taking legal opinion," he said.

MOTIHARI ASSAULT Deputy CM accuses prof of exaggerating about injuries

AT A time when Mahatma Gandhi Central University in Motihari remains closed following the assault on an assistant professor after his Facebook posts critical of former PM Atal Bihari Vajpayee, Deputy Chief Minister Sushil Kumar Modi Friday accused the faculty member of exaggerating about injuries and trying to "evoke sympathy of media and Left liberals".

He accused the media of highlighting the "superficial injuries" of Sanjay Kumar, an assistant professor in the sociology department, and playing down his "highly offensive" posts.

Sushil Kumar Modi told *The Indian Express*, "On the day when the country was overwhelmed with emotion, paying tributes to the former PM Vajpayee, professor Sanjay Kumar posted three highly offensive posts, one of them calling Atalji a 'fascist'. While leaders across the political spectrum were united in grief, there were few who criticised and condemned the post. But when the professor dramatised the assault on him, several Left liberals came to his support and his original offence was almost overlooked. Though there are two cases against professor Kumar... they were underplayed."

BENGAL PANCHAYAT POLLS SC refuses to cancel polls in seats that TMC won unopposed

THE SUPREME COURT on Friday refused to set aside the elections to the 20,159 seats won unopposed by Trinamool Congress candidates in the local body polls in West Bengal. The opposition had accused the ruling party of resorting to violence to prevent its candidates from filing nominations. The court said that each case will have to be examined separately by way of an election petition and it cannot make a "general assumption".

"For this court to set aside elections to over 20,000 seats would be to prejudice the basic issue as to whether in each of those constituencies, the election stands vitiated by obstruction having been caused to candidates from filing their nominations. A general assumption of this nature cannot be made. Ultimately, whether this is correct would depend upon the evidence adduced in the facts of individual cases where such a grievance has been made in an election petition," a bench of Chief Justice of India Dipak Misra and Justices A M

TMC HAILS VERDICT

Kolkata: TMC chief and West Bengal CM Mamata Banerjee described the verdict as "people's victory" and "defeat of the joint conspiracy by three opposition parties." State BJP chief Dilip Ghosh said, "We accept the verdict. We will fight TMC democratically in the next Lok Sabha elections." **ENS**

Khanwilkar and D Y Chandrachud ruled.

The court cited its limitations to intervene in the matter and said that an election petition was the way out. "The electoral process is afforded sanctity in a democracy. That is the reason why in a consistent line of precedent, this court has insisted (earlier judgments) upon the discipline of the law being followed so that any challenge to the validity of an election has to be addressed by adopting the remedy of an election petition provided under the governing statute," the bench said in its judgment.

From illegal immigrant to legal citizen, after 4-month detention

SAMIRAN NESSA celebrated Wednesday's Eid ul-Zuha (Bakrid) at her home in Assam's Goalpara district as an Indian citizen.

On August 17, after years as a suspected illegal immigrant, and spending the last four months in a women's detention camp for illegal foreigners in Kokrajhar, she was declared an Indian and freed.

Nessa, an illiterate and unmarried woman who made a living by washing dishes at roadside eateries, was declared an illegal foreigner by a Foreigners Tribunal of Goalpara in July last year in her absence. Her case came up in the tribunal after she was marked as a Doubtful or D-voter in 2005.

The tribunals — 100 across the

state — are quasi-judicial bodies tasked to "furnish opinion on the question as to whether a person is or is not a foreigner within the meaning of Foreigners Act, 1946". The tribunals get two kinds of cases: those against whom a reference has been made by the border wing of the Assam Police or those against whose names in the

electoral rolls a D is marked. The D-Voter category was introduced in Assam in 1997 to mark out people who were unable to prove their citizenship during verification.

Nessa has in her mind a vivid snapshot of April 9. She had left home in the morning for work at a tea-stall in nearby Mornoi, where policemen identified her and took her to the local police station.

"A medical check-up was done. Then, I was sent to police in Goalpara town for taking my finger-impression and photograph and then sent off to the detention camp in Kokrajhar," she said.

"I was numb with fear and do not remember much - but by 7 pm I was inside the camp and went to sleep," said Nessa.

Kokrajhar camp, set up in April 2010 to shelter "foreigner" women,

is one of the six camps in Assam that together hold over 900 detainees. "It is a camp for women - I have met both Muslims and Hindus. In my ward, there were over 40 women. Food, water, mosquito net were provided and a doctor comes when someone falls ill," she said. But what tortured her was boredom. "There is nothing to do - we cannot do any work," she said.

"We used to get up in the morning, have tea and then sit and kill time. At 10 am, we got food and again till 4 pm, we just had to talk to each other and pass time. At 4 pm, we got our final meal of the day. The door of our room would open at 7 am and up to 5 pm, we could go out into the designated space for women. There was one TV also," she said.

RJD slams Patna HC 'gag' order on Muzaffarpur shelter

RJD NATIONAL vice-president Shivanand Tewary on Friday criticised the Patna High Court's decision to restrain the media from reporting on the Muzaffarpur shelter abuse case, saying it was "nothing less than a gag order" and went "against the very spirit of the right to know as enshrined in the RTI Act".

The RJD leader said the order "violated" the provisions of the "freedom of expression". In a verbal order on Thursday, the Patna High Court said that "till the investigation is completed, all the print and electronic media are hereby restrained from reporting anything with respect to the case, more particularly, with respect to the investigation already undertaken and/or which is likely to take place as it may seriously hamper the investigation of the case."

It also directed the state government and the CBI "to see that the above order is complied with by everyone."

"It is only because of media coverage of the Muzaffarpur case that the Supreme Court took suo motu cognizance of the case... Media has covered many important cases, including the fodder scam," said Tewary. He said a "blanket ban" on covering the case would mean that people would not get to know many facts which are in public interest. The RJD leader asked the court to reconsider its decision. "The HC order is not in consonance with the spirit of the right to know as enshrined in the RTI Act and is also against freedom of expression," he said.

The JD(U) and BJP declined to comment on the court's decision. "Why should we react to the court's order. It has been monitoring the Muzaffarpur case and is competent to take a call," said a BJP leader.

A senior JD(U) leader also echoed similar sentiments. Meanwhile, Santosh Kumar, one of the petitioners said: "We are exploring the possibility of moving the Supreme Court against that part of the HC order which restrains media coverage... Now, the media may not cover any shelter irregularity case. Our common concern is to rectify the manner in which shelter houses are being run over the years."
